Page 11	Left column, 3rd full paragraph, line 17, there is text missing. It should read: ' of a more satisfactory blue substitute paper in November. The line-perforated 10/- value, printed on the 'ordinary' surfaced green paper, was initially rejected '.
Page 12	Left column, 1st full paragraph, line 15. '21?' should be '21%' (fraction seven-eighths).
Page 15	Fig. 30, amend 'Ex DLR Archive' to 'Ex CA Archive'.
Page 39	Penultimate paragraph: the two '?'s should be replaced with fractions ½ and ½ respectively.
Page 70	The text at lower left corner states ' no breaks appearing in the head plate line'. Change word 'head' to read 'frame'.
Page 80	Under Requisition 2401/1, add a final paragraph to read 'This requisition also included the printing of a 50c revenue in the small key plate format. Only a single printing of this value was made.'
Page 87	Under Requisition 2046/6, 6th line, ' 20.3.38 11/37 printing' should read ' 20.1.38 11/37 printing'.

Page 98	Requisition 3366/2. First line giving sheet quantities. two '?'s should be replaced with fractions $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{3}$ respectively.
Page 99	Requisition 3412/1. Two lines giving sheet quantities: in each line repace two '?'s with fractions $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ respectively. Requisition 3436/1. First line giving sheet quantities: two '?'s should be replaced with fractions $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ respectively.
Page 100	Requisition 3591/2. First line giving sheet quantities: two '?'s should be replaced with fractions \( \frac{1}{2} \) and \( \frac{1}{2} \) respectively.
Page 101	Requisition 3602/1. First line giving sheet quantities: two '?'s should be replaced with fractions ½ and ½ respectively.
Page 113	Fig. 107: '4 June 1941' should read '4 July 1941'.
Page 121	To Fig. 121 description ending ' to UK.', add 'Overpaid 3d.'
Page 143	Requisition 889/?. Fourth line of paragraph: '?' should read '5/6'.
Page 144	Requisition 976/1. First line giving sheet quantities for the 10/-: two '?'s should be replaced with fractions $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{3}$ respectively.
Page 145	Requisition 984/1. First line giving sheet quantities for the 10/-: two '?'s should be replaced with fractions $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{2}{3}$ respectively.
Page 166	Third line from bottom: delete 'All sheets were numbered consecutively.' (phrase is duplicated).
Page 167	Under Requisition 1265/1, remove the last sentence beginning 'Sheet number 346 is known' (the report of this number appearing on the second printing, rather than on the first, may not be correct).
Page 182	Fig. 153. Replace '//xxMONxxxx//' in the caption with '//date//'.
Page 205	2/- BFF 48: 'lower right corner' should read 'lower left corner'.
Page 240	The images of Flaws 60 and 60b have been transposed.
Page 244	Leeward 984/1 10/ The number under 'Bureau' should be 10,000.

See separate sheet. Pages 285/6 These pages should be transposed.

Page 257

Nyasaland 10/- November 1937 printing. At 'Issued', replace word 'unknown' with '1 January 1938'; at 'Earliest known Page 338 use' replace '7 December 1945' with '1 January 1938'; under 'Quantity to Colony', replace dispatch date 'January 1938' with '29 November 1937'.

Page 341 At 'Quantity to Colony', the year in the despatch date should be 1938, not 1937.
