Royal hosts China exhibition

The Royal Philatelic Society London was recently honoured to be invited to host the China Stamp Exhibition, one of the 2012 London Book Fair China Market Focus events.

The exhibition, open on April 16 to 18, 2012, included The 1897 Red Revenue Surcharges of China of Mr Ding Jin Song, the Large Dragon Stamps and Proofs of Mr Sun Jiang Tao, in addition to stamps depicting China's traditional culture and aspects of Chinese stamp printing shown by the China National Post and Postage Stamp Museum.

At the Opening Ceremony, a welcome was extended by the Chinese Ambassador to the United Kingdom, His Excellency Liu Xiaoming, the Deputy Director General of the State Post Bureau of The People's Republic of China, Mr Xu Jian Zhou, and by the President of The Royal Philatelic Society London, Mr Brian Trotter.

The exhibition was declared open following the cutting of a ribbon by Mr Xu Jian Zhou and Mr Brian Trotter, accompanied by Mr Wu Shulin, Deputy Director General of The General Administration of Press and Publications of The People's Republic of China, and Mr Harvey Marshall, Lord Mayor Locum Tenens of Westminster.
