Postage Due Mail shown at Royal

Nearly 130 Fellows, members and guests enjoyed the display given by Patrick Frost on 7 June to The Royal Philatelic Society London. The material examined Great Britain Postage Due Mail from 1839 to the present day, with many fine items were shown, starting with the introduction of the Uniform 4d Post on December 5, 1839.

However, as Chris Harman, giving the vote of thanks, explained, it is the more modern material that is often harder to find and thus much scarcer. Chris described this as 'a wonderful display of sophisticated material'.

The various handstamps, charge marks, and explanatory markings were comprehensively shown, as was the use of postage due stamps. The display included Official Mail, Jury Summons, Parliamentary Proceedings, as well as examples of Registration, Express Delivery, Book Post and Parcel Post.

The President, Brian Trotter, presented Patrick with the Society's plaque in recognition of a display that had been greatly appreciated by all present.
