Members from Wales and Herefordshire impress

It was the turn of the members from Wales and Herefordshire to provide the displays at the meeting of The Royal Philatelic Society London on Thursday, 30 January.

The exhibits were introduced by John Perry, one of the Society's representatives for the area, who explained that it had taken about a year to put together, but that it has been a pleasure.

The thanks of the members were expressed by Mike Roberts, who commented that among the 18 wide-ranging displays, nearly half were of Welsh postal history. He paid particular tribute to Nicholas and Janet Nelson for showing Ifni, a territory with just one post office, whose stamps are probably best remembered from one's schooldays.

Just as remarkable was Michael Bale's showing of mail sent to and from Lundy, including a card sent to Papua New Guinea, and then returned.
