Superb Canada starts Royal's new season

At its first meeting of each new season, the members of The Royal Philatelic Society London are always privileged to see a selection of material from the Royal Philatelic Collection, shown by gracious permission of Her Majesty The Queen.

This year the Keeper of the Royal Philatelic Collection, Michael Sefi, chose to show material relating to Canada and its Provinces. Included were a vast array of superb items, much exceedingly rare, relating to the Colony of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, British Columbia, Prince Edward Island, Vancouver Island and the Dominion of Canada. In addition to the issued stamps, many in multiples, the display also included a wealth of die and plate proofs.

Giving the vote of thanks, Richard Stock thanked Michael Sefi and his team at the Royal Philatelic Collection for providing such a magnificent display. He commented that the tone had been set by the very first frame in which was shown the 12d black of Canada issued in June 1851.
