Superlative Revenues shown to Royal

The members of The Royal Philatelic Society London were privileged to see a display and presentation of Revenue stamps from the West Indies at the meeting on 13 October. The material was shown by Michael Medlicott, and represented just a small portion of a collection that runs to around 10,000 pages.

The countries featured were British Guiana, Grenada, Jamaica, Leeward Islands, Montserrat, St Christopher (St Kitts), St Vincent, and Trinidad & Tobago. Shown were mint and used, including multiples, sometimes complete sheets, plus artists' sketches, essays, proofs and varieties. For what are in many cases extremely rare items, the condition throughout was superlative.

The collection is, without doubt, the finest ever assembled of this material; members were delighted to have this opportunity to admire the selection that was on show.
