The 'Royal' to seek new London premises

The Royal Philatelic Society London has been based at 41 Devonshire Place in London since 1925: this is a wonderful 'heritage' building that dates from the 1790s. However, as the Society grows, so the need has arisen to find more suitable premises.

In recent years the Royal has expanded in terms of membership, attendance at meetings and its collections, and continues to do so, meaning that 'No. 41' is no longer fit for purpose.

The Council of the Royal has looked long and hard at ways of renovating its much-loved headquarters, but no affordable scheme has been identified that fulfils all of the present and future needs.

The current President, Frank Walton, RDP FRPSL, explains: 'Although every member has very fond memories and attachments to our Marylebone home, the level of support for the decision to seek a new home has been overwhelming.'
