Two members explore Jamaica

Steve Jarvis and Paul Wright took members of The Royal Philatelic Society London on a visit to Jamaica with their display on 26 January. The material shown spanned from pre-adhesive and Great Britain used in Jamaica, to the issues of the reigns of Queen Victoria through to Queen Elizabeth II and the post-Independence stamps. Included throughout were essays, proofs, colour trials, Specimens and varieties.

Also shown were various postmarks and markings, including accountancy and instructional marks, plus air and maritime mail.

Giving the vote of thanks, Graham Booth commented that while Jamaica is a relatively small island, it has produced much material, congratulating both Steve and Paul on the depth of their displays. In response, they remarked that they had tried to include items to interest everyone, hoping that all had learnt something from the material shown.
