Members share their knowledge and passion

Members of The Royal Philatelic Society London from London and Surrey provided the displays at the Society's meeting on 27 April. Material was shown by 24 members demonstrating great diversity, from the Great Western Railway's Airmails to Telegraph Forms and early Telegrams, from Protective Underprints and Overprints to South Georgia postal history.

Particularly unusual was the display of letters sent to the BBC World Service. The sender did not always have the address correct, yet Post Office staff managed to ensure it was delivered correctly. Equally many of the letters bore stamps relegated by stamp catalogue editors to 'appendix' status.

In thanking all who had contributed John Davies FRPSL noted how all had 'shared their knowledge and passion for what they collect, and thereby were inspiring others'. Peter Lister FRPSL, who had co-ordinated the displays, was particularly thanked for all his hard work.
