War Memorial re-dedicated

The War Memorial at the home of the Royal Philatelic Society London in the City of London was re-dedicated by the Bishop of London, the Rt Revd and Rt Hon. Sarah Mullally DBE on Wednesday, 7 December 2022.

The premises at 15 Abchurch Lane were originally built in 1915 for the Gresham Club that closed in 1991. When the building was acquired by the Royal in 2018, the War Memorial was found in a rather neglected state. The Memorial records those members of the Club that served in the Great War, including eight who gave their lives. With the help of funding from the War Memorials Trust, the Memorial has been refurbished and now can be seen on the first floor.

At a short service on 7 December the Memorial was re-dedicated by the Bishop of London, who spoke of how we all should look at our own lives in the pursuit of peace.
