An incredible contribution

'Aspects of Great Britain Postal History before 1840' was the title of the display given by Peter Chadwick FRPSL to the members of the Royal Philatelic Society London on 23 November. What was on show was an incredible array of material from the Bishop Marks up to the introduction of Uniform Fourpenny Post in December 1839.

'Absolutely fantastic' was how President of the Society, Michael Roberts FRPSL, described the display, sentiments echoed by Greg Spring FRPSL giving the Vote of Thanks.
