The Following Notices Were Issued From the Office of the Postmaster General

OLD-AGE AND SURVIVORS INSURANCE

Acknowledgment of Claimants' Signatures

The Bureau of Old-Age and Survivors Insurance of the Social Security Board operates under regulations requiring claimants for insurance benefits to acknowledge their signatures on applications.

To save time and travel on the part of claimants, postmasters of third- and fourth-class post offices and rural carriers serving routes emanating from such offices are directed to administer oaths upon applications and supporting forms for insurance benefits under title II of the Social Security Act when presented by claimants. Rural carriers serving routes emanating from first- and second-class post offices will administer such oaths during their official tours of duty in serving their routes.

The acknowledgement will consist of witnessing the signature of the claimant and it is, of course, understood that no charge shall be made for administering the oaths. (Postal Bulletin No. 18477, August 17, 1942.)

TERMINATION OF THE AUTHORITY OF THE INLAND BONDING COMPANY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA, TO QUALIFY AS SURETY ON FEDERAL BONDS

To the Heads of Bureaus, Bond-Approving Officers, and Others Concerned:

Notice is hereby given that the certificate of authority issued by the Secretary of the Treasury to the Inland Bonding Co., South Bend, Ind., under the provisions of the act of Congress approved August 13, 1894, 28 Stat. 279-80, as amended by the Act of Congress approved March 23, 1910, 36 Stat. 241, (U. S. Code, title 6, secs. 6-13) to qualify as sole surety on recognizances, stipulations, bonds, and undertakings permitted or required by the laws of the United States, terminated on July 27, 1942.

The Inland Bonding Co. received its initial authority from the Treasury to do business with the United States on February 23, 1926, and remained continuously so qualified until July 27, 1942, and the company has requested permission from the Treasury to voluntarily retire from the execution of any new business in favor of the United States.

In order that there may be a coordinated record showing the status of outstanding bonds of this company as of July 27, 1942, in favor of the United States, bond-approving officers are requested to examine immediately the records of their offices and report promptly to the Section of Surety Bonds, Bureau of Accounts, Treasury Department, all outstanding bonds accepted by them and executed by the Inland Bonding Co. as surety or cosurety on which the liability of the company has not terminated.

It is also requested that the Section of Surety Bonds be advised as expeditiously as possible as to all facts, in detail, relating to any existing claim, or with respect to the occurrence of any event or the existence of any circumstance which may hereafter result in a claim against the Inland Bonding Co.

In furnishing the above information bond-approving officers will please give the name of the principal on the bond, the date and penalty of the bond, and with respect to claims, the nature of the claim, the circumstances out of which it arose, and its status at the time of the report.

Bond-approving officers and other agents of the Government charged with the duty of taking bonds, recognizances, stipulations or undertakings should proceed immediately to secure new bonds, where necessary, with acceptable sureties, in lieu of bonds executed or reinsured by the Inland Bonding Co. (Postal Bulletin No. 18474, August 10, 1942.)

NEWS RELEASES

To Be Confined to Postal Matters

The attention of postmasters, supervisory officials, and all others connected with the Postal Service is directed to the instructions contained in section 12, paragraph a of Regulation No. 1, dated July 10, 1942, issued by the Director of Office of War Information, which reads as follows:

"a. The field services of each Federal Department or agency will be responsible for preparing and disseminating information not related significantly to the war effort. The head of each Federal Department or agency shall instruct his field employees to release in the field only such information as is within clearly defined policy and exclusively within the authorized activities of his agency."

As in the past, postmasters will be permitted to publicize strictly postal developments and postal news of general interest, including information regarding volume sales of War Savings bonds, as authorized in Postal Bulletin No. 18434 of May 8, 1942. Postmasters should be governed accordingly in making statements to the public or press. (Postal Bulletin No. 18474, August 10, 1942.)

LIMITS IN WEIGHT AND DIMENSIONS OF MAIL FOR DELIVERY OUTSIDE THE CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES

ORDER No. 18564.

Since the issuance of Order No. 17471, Army Post Offices outside the continental United States have been established as branches of United States post offices other than those named in paragraph 1 (b) of that Order. Therefore, said paragraph, which defines the term "mail addressed for delivery 'outside the continental United States,'" is amended to read as follows:

"b. All mail addressed to Army Post Offices (A. P. O.'s) in care of the Postmaster at New York, N. Y., San Francisco, Calif., Seattle, Wash., New Orleans, La., Miami, Fla., or Presque Isle, Maine." (Postal Bulletin No. 18483, August 31, 1942.)

RESTRICTION OF PRINTED MATTER FOR DISPATCH TO NEUTRAL EUROPEAN COUNTRIES

ORDER No. 18599.

With the view of controlling the exportation to neutral countries in Europe of matter that may be released by publishers for purely domestic distribution, of

alleviating the possibility of transmission by individuals of harmful messages through such medium, and of relieving as much as possible the transportation problem of handling international mails under present conditions, the following restrictions shall become effective immediately:

Printed matter originating in the United States or Canada, addressed to European neutral countries, will not be permitted to go forward to destination unless mailed by—

- (a) The publishers or registered news agents;
- (b) Firms or organizations for which the material is published;
- (c) The publisher's distributing agency.

Individuals and concerns not within the above groups will be permitted, under certain conditions, to export printed matter under license to be issued by the Office of Censorship or the Board of Economic Warfare. Printed matter, the exportation of which is licensed, will bear notation, including the license number, on the outer wrapper. Printed matter not bearing appropriate license indicia on the outer wrapper from individuals and concerns not classified within groups (a), (b), and (c), when mailed in the United States, United States possessions, and the Canal Zone, will be appropriately endorsed by the Censorship authorities and returned to the sender. Such printed matter, when mailed by individuals and concerns in Canada, will be forwarded under cover to the Chief Postal Censor, Ottawa, Canada, by the Censorship Station.

Printed matter as referred to herein will include books, magazines, pamphlets, booklets, circulars, catalogs, news letters, newspapers and advertising material, whether printed, mimeographed, or otherwise mechanically duplicated, and clippings therefrom. It does not include securities, bills of lading, invoices, statements of accounts, or other business forms of a similar nature used in commerce and exchange. It does not include A. P. O. mail and mail of Government agencies.

Post offices will please advise interested patrons as far as practicable of these restrictions and decline to accept the prohibited printed matter for mailing. Should such unacceptable articles of printed matter be received in the mails, the post office of mailing should return them to the senders appropriately marked. Any of such prohibited articles as may reach the exchange office, shall be submitted to the Censorship Station and after examination shall be returned to the senders (Postal Bulletin No. 18484, September 2, 1942.)

AIR-MAIL RESTRICTIONS

MATTER DESTINED OUTSIDE CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES

ORDER NO. 18605.

The War and Navy Departments exercise control over the transportation of air mail to overseas destinations. Reports received during the past few weeks show conclusively that the volume of air mail now being received for transmission to certain points outside the continental United States is greatly exceeding and will continue greatly to exceed the facilities that are or can be made available for that purpose. Therefore, it becomes necessary to materially reduce the weight of individual pieces of air mail so that the transportation by air of the greatest possible number of letters to those areas may be assured.

The existing military demands upon air-transportation facilities for strategic cargo and for personnel essential to the war effort have made necessary the immediate establishment of the following order of preference in the loading of mail on aircraft destined for restricted areas:

- First..... Official air mail.
- Second..... V-Mail.
- Third..... **To the extent space is available**, other letter mail weighing not in excess of 2 ounces per letter.

The public should be informed that the quantities of air mail coming within the third category that can be given air dispatch to the restricted areas cannot be accurately predicted, and such matter may have to be transported by surface

means. Military necessity may later require that only official air mail and V-Mail be transported by air to these areas.

Until further notice, therefore, only letters in their usual and ordinary form weighing not in excess of two ounces and coming within the third category may be accepted as air mail for transmission to foreign countries and to overseas Navy post offices and A. P. O.'s.

Packages of merchandise, prints, etc. (except official packages) will not be carried by air from the United States.

The foregoing restrictions apply to air mail for all points outside the limits of the continental United States except that for the time being they will not apply to Mexico, Central America and South America, the West Indies, and other islands within the Caribbean area, Alaska, Canada, and Newfoundland.

Postmasters will please instruct their patrons as far as practicable without expense to the Department of these changes in the manner of handling air mail and further urge upon their patrons the importance of using V-Mail for messages to persons in the military service outside the United States and of using the lightest possible stationery for other overseas correspondence.

The foregoing instructions are effective immediately. (Postal Bulletin No. 18485, September 4, 1942.)

AMENDMENTS TO POSTAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS

The amendments to the Postal Laws and Regulations printed at the back of the supplements should be carefully preserved. They are printed on only one side of the page so that they may be clipped and pasted directly opposite the section amended or may be pasted in a separate blank book, the margin of each section amended being marked with the number of the insert affecting that particular section. The following subject is treated in the amendment published this month:

Insert No.

- 85. No deposit with the Treasurer of the United States nor remittance to Central Depository of less than \$50 except on last day of month.
- 86. No deposit of less than \$50 to be made in banks except on last day of month.
- 87. Handling of formal entry shipments not addressed to a customs port.
- 88. Matches prohibited in overseas domestic mails.

FRAUD ORDER

Since the publication of the August 1942 Supplement to the Official Postal Guide the following fraud order has been issued against the following party:

All mail addressed to this party should be returned to senders, stamped "Fraudulent—Mail to this address returned by order of Postmaster General," and no money orders in favor of said party should be issued or certified. (Postal Bulletin No. 18476, August 14, 1942.)

SEDITIONS OR SUBVERSIVE MATTER

Three Copies Desired for Ruling

On January 15, 1942, notice was published in the Postal Bulletin calling on all postmasters to forward subversive matter to the Solicitor for ruling as to its mailability under the provisions of section 600, Postal Laws and Regulations (1940) (18 U. S. Code 343, 50 U. S. Code 33).

In all cases in which available *three* copies of such matter should be withdrawn from the mails and forwarded with the request for ruling. (Postal Bulletin No. 18473, August 7, 1942.)

REFUNDS OF RETIREMENT DEDUCTIONS

Notices concerning the extension of retirement privileges to assistant postmasters and clerks at third-class post offices appeared in the Postal Bulletins of May 27, June 19, and July 10, 1942.

Some postmasters have made refunds of retirement deductions to employees upon their separation from the service. Once deductions are taken it is necessary that refunds be made by the Civil Service Commission and any separated employee who desires to withdraw the amount of retirement deductions to his credit at the time of separation should file claim therefor on Form 3005. Retirement deductions should not be refunded by any postmaster.

Inquiries received at this office indicate that all postmasters have not familiarized themselves with the instructions outlined in the Postal Bulletin of July 10, 1942. It is requested that this Bulletin be reviewed before any question concerning the retirement status of the employees referred to therein is submitted to this office. (Postal Bulletin No. 18478, August 19, 1942.)

ENEMY ALIEN REGISTRATION

Forwarding of Forms to Division of Alien Registration

It has been brought to the attention of the Department that some postmasters are not complying with the instructions relative to the forwarding of applications for certificates of identification which have been submitted by enemy aliens in connection with the enemy alien registration.

The attention of postmasters is therefore especially called to the instructions in the Postal Bulletin of January 23, 1942, under item 17 (b) and 25. Note new address here below.

Postmasters are therefore instructed to return immediately to the Alien Registration Division, Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice, 15th and Chestnut Streets, Philadelphia, Pa., any incomplete or undeliverable alien enemy applications or certificates which are now being held. (Postal Bulletin No. 18474, August 10, 1942.)

REVISION OF FORM 1513-A

Under the provisions of amended article 13, page 36 of the July 1941 Official Postal Guide, Form 1513-A should be suitably altered pending its revision to indicate that the addressee should call at the post office or carrier delivery station for parcel that failed of delivery on the carrier's first attempt. (Postal Bulletin No. 18476, August 14, 1942.)

FORMS 1525-1, 1525-2, AND 1525-3

While it has heretofore been the practice to transmit to postmasters proper forms for this purpose, forms must hereafter be obtained on requisition from the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Building Operations and Supplies, Equipment and Supplies Branch.

However, without requisition, an initial supply of the forms 1525-1, 1525-2, and 1525-3 will be furnished postmasters of first- and second-class post offices and

third-class city and village carrier offices, respectively. The forms must be preserved and used at the appropriate time to submit the required quarterly report of gross receipts and expenditures for auxiliary hire and overtime.

The forms should be executed in duplicate, the original forwarded to the Bureau of the First Assistant and the copy retained for the postmaster's files. (Postal Bulletin No. 18476, August 14, 1942.)

RESTRICTIONS ON FURNISHING TESTIMONIALS AND INFORMATION REGARDING POSTAL PATRONS

Contrary to the instructions appearing in article 15, page 125 of the July 1941 Postal Guide, official testimonials and information regarding postal patrons are being furnished by postmasters to war industry officials or their investigators.

This practice should be discontinued. There will be no objection, however, to compliance with requests for information concerning postal employees or former postal employees seeking employment in war industries, provided the information is readily available and the work involved is not such as to interfere with regular postal functions. (Postal Bulletin No. 18477, August 17, 1942.)

SUSPENSION OF SERVICE OTHER THAN FOR LETTERS TO SWEDEN

There being no service available for the transportation thereof, mails for Sweden, other than letter mails in their usual and ordinary form, will not be given dispatch. Mailers should be advised accordingly. If mails other than letters in their usual and ordinary form should be posted, however, they should be sent onward to the exchange office of New York from which they will be returned to senders after release by the censorship authorities. Letter mails in their usual and ordinary form for Sweden (air mails and surface) will be accepted as heretofore. (Postal Bulletin No. 18475, August 12, 1942.)

GIFT PACKAGES CONTAINING TOBACCO AND OTHER ARTICLES ADDRESSED TO AMERICAN CITIZENS SERVING IN THE CIVILIAN TECHNICAL CORPS IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

Reference is made to the announcement under the above caption appearing in the Postal Bulletin of December 18, 1941, and on page 13 of the January 1942 Supplement to the Postal Guide, in which it was stated that gift packages containing tobacco and other articles not exceeding 5 pounds in weight nor containing more than 2 pounds of any one product are admitted duty-free to American citizens serving in the Civilian Technical Corps in the United Kingdom. Such packages must be addressed to the individual by name in care of the Commandant, Civilian Technical Corps, Eglan Court, 7 Knyveton Road, Bournemouth, Hants., England.

Information has been received in this Department that some post offices are refusing packages addressed to the said members on the grounds that they are not in the Armed Forces of the United States.

Postmasters are directed to instruct those concerned at their offices to accept packages addressed to members serving in the Civilian Technical Corps when prepared in accordance with the instructions contained in the above-mentioned notice. (Postal Bulletin No. 18480, August 24, 1942.)

MAILS AND PARCELS EXCHANGED WITH PRISONERS OF WAR AND DETAINED OR INTERNED CIVILIANS

Effective September 7, 1942, mails and parcels originating in, destined to, and transiting the United States, to and from prisoners of war and interned or detained civilians, are to be forwarded to New York, N. Y., for censorship, instead of Chicago, Ill. Therefore, effective September 7, persons in the United States corresponding with prisoners of war and interned or detained civilians, should endorse mails and parcels "Via New York, N. Y." instead of "Via Chicago, Ill."

Postmasters should give wide publicity to the foregoing without expense to the Department. (Postal Bulletin No. 18484, September 2, 1942.)

BOLIVIA—USED CLOTHING REQUIRES DISINFECTION CERTIFICATE

The Postal Administration of Bolivia has advised that used clothing or other used personal effects imported into that country must be accompanied by a

certificate of disinfection issued by a competent authority in the country of origin and legalized by a consular representative of Bolivia.

The certificate of disinfection may be obtained by senders from the local board of health or from some firm with facilities for disinfecting the articles involved. Senders are to endorse the wrappers of parcels containing used clothing or other used personal effects addressed to Bolivia to show that the certificate of disinfection is enclosed.

A list showing the locations of Bolivian consuls in the United States appears on page 99 of Part II of the Official Postal Guide for July 1941. However, Pittsburgh, Pa., should be substituted for Ridgewood, N. J., in the said list. (Postal Bulletin No. 18486 September 7, 1942.)

DIVISION OF AIR MAIL SERVICE

Air mail service temporarily discontinued on route A. M. 35, Cheyenne-Huron and on route A. M. 48, Minneapolis-Des Moines; Des Moines-St. Louis and Des Moines-Kansas City on account of withdrawal of aircraft equipment for use of the Army was resumed August 15, 1942, for mail. The schedules are as follows: A. M. 35, leave Huron 2 p. m., arrive Cheyenne 5:25 p. m. Leave Cheyenne 7:45 a. m., arrive Huron 1:10 p. m. A. M. 48, leave Minneapolis 7:30 a. m., Des Moines 10 a. m., arrive St. Louis 12:25 p. m.; leave Des Moines 10:15 a. m., arrive Kansas City 11:45 a. m. Leave Kansas City 1:30 p. m., arrive Des Moines 3 p. m.; leave St. Louis 1 p. m., Des Moines 3:35 p. m., arrive Minneapolis 5:55 p. m.

Air mail service on new route A. M. 58, between Detroit and Cincinnati was inaugurated August 15, 1942, with intermediate stops at Toledo and Dayton. DIVISION OF CLASSIFICATION

NEWSPAPER PUBLICITY STATEMENTS DUE OCTOBER 1, 1942

The statements of ownership, management, circulation, etc., of publications entered as second-class matter, except such publications as have been exempted, required to be submitted annually, in duplicate, by the act of March 3, 1933, are due not later than October 1, 1942. Postmasters should, therefore, furnish copies of Form 3526 to the publishers required to submit such statements.

Publishers of foreign publications entered as second-class matter in this country must also file the required statement of ownership, management, circulation, etc.

After being carefully examined to see that they are fully completed, the original copies of statements should promptly be sent to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Classification. Care should be taken to see that full information is furnished under each of the items of the form. Reports should be made on October 10 of the names of any publications which have not filed the required statements.

Careful attention with respect to the foregoing is invited to section 537, Postal Laws and Regulations.

Copies of publications in which such statements are printed should not be sent to the Department, but should be retained in the files of the post office as prescribed by paragraph 4 of the section mentioned.

V-MAIL

Proper Addressing

Many V-Mail letters are being received at V-Mail stations without the name and address of the addressee being shown in the panel at the top of the message side of the sheet. The information in the panel is photographed, as well as the message, and when reproduced at destination, serves as the address for the message when it is placed in a window envelope. Unless the name and address are shown in the panel, letters will be returned to senders by the V-Mail stations.

A properly completed V-Mail letter sheet should be prominently displayed in the lobby of every post office, branch, and station, classified, contract or rural, and patrons should be cautioned at the time V-Mail letter sheets are handed to them, to print the name and address of the addressee in the panel on the message side.

Postmasters and postal employees will encourage the use of the V-Mail Service at every opportunity. (Postal Bulletin No. 18475, August 12, 1942.)

AIR MAIL TO PUERTO RICO

Due to misunderstanding as to the proper rate of postage applicable to air mail addressed to Puerto Rico, a considerable quantity of short paid matter of this kind is being deposited in the mails. The work incident to rating the matter, collecting the postage due, etc., not only delays the delivery of the mail but imposes a burden upon both the Postal Service and the addressee.

The proper rate of postage on air mail sent from the continental United States to persons and concerns (other than members of the armed forces of the United States) in Puerto Rico is 10 cents for each half ounce or fraction thereof. Postmasters are requested to see that postage at this rate is prepaid in all cases and to make a special effort to bring this to the attention of patrons who do not affix the required amount of postage to air mail intended for delivery in Puerto Rico.

The importance of prepaying the full amount chargeable should be emphasized, although if one full rate, namely, 10 cents, is prepaid on matter chargeable with more postage, the matter may be rated with the deficiency to be collected on delivery.

Attention is called to the fact that the rate of postage on air mail addressed to members of our armed forces stationed outside the continental United States is 6 cents for each half-ounce or fraction thereof, and that it is important that postage chargeable at such rate also be fully prepaid. (Postal Bulletin No. 18476, August 14, 1942.)

PREPARATION OF FREE MAIL FROM MEMBERS OF OUR ARMED FORCES

Some postmasters refuse to accept for mailing free of postage letters and post cards mailed by members of the United States military or naval forces under the provisions of the law embodied in amended section 515, Postal Laws and Regulations, because the name of the sender, his rank or rating, designation of the service to which he belongs, and the word "Free" are typewritten, hand-stamped, or printed on the envelopes or cards instead of being hand-written, while in other cases such envelopes and cards are rated up with postage due.

While, in the notice published in the Postal Bulletin for July 10, 1942, it was stated that such inscriptions shall be in the handwriting of the sender on the envelopes or cards, in order to be accepted free of postage, it was not contemplated that where such inscriptions are typewritten, hand-stamped, or printed in whole or in part the matter should be refused or postage due collected on delivery. In such instances the postmasters at the offices of mailing should, when feasible, advise the senders or the commanding officers as to the requirements in this respect.

Cards and envelopes which have already been printed with the name of the sender, his rank or rating, the designation of the service to which he belongs, and the word "Free" may be accepted until the supply on hand is exhausted, with the understanding that thereafter these inscriptions will be hand-written. Printers and others supplying envelopes and cards to members of the armed forces should discontinue the practice of printing these inscriptions. (Postal Bulletin No. 18477, August 17, 1942.)

ARIZONA PLANT QUARANTINE

Amendment of Notice Dated November 10, 1941

Item 6 of the notice of November 10, 1941, published in the Postal Bulletin of November 17, 1941, relating to Arizona plant quarantines is amended by removing "Plum trees and parts thereof, except fruit pits" from the prohibited list (column II) and placing these articles in the restricted list (column III) so that the amended item will read:

CHRISTMAS MAIL FOR MEMBERS OF ARMED FORCES ABROAD

Arrangements have been made by the Post Office Department in cooperation with the War and Navy Departments for the acceptance of Christmas parcels for members of our armed forces serving outside the continental United States. (For the purpose of these instructions Alaska is included in the term "outside the continental United States.") In order that such parcels may reach the addressees on time and in good condition, postmasters are requested to bring the following requirements to the attention of mailers:

Time of mailing.—Christmas parcels and Christmas cards should be mailed during the period beginning October 1 and ending November 1, 1942, the earlier the better. Patrons should be encouraged to endorse each gift parcel "Christmas Parcel." Special effort will be made to effect delivery of all Christmas parcels mailed during that period in time for Christmas.

Size and weight.—In view of the urgent need for shipping space to transport materials directly essential to the war effort, Christmas parcels shall not exceed the present limits of 11 pounds in weight or 18 inches in length or 42 inches in length and girth combined. Nevertheless the public is urged by the War and Navy Departments to cooperate by voluntarily restricting the size of Christmas parcels to that of an ordinary shoe box, and the weight to 6 pounds. These departments have pointed out also that members of the Armed Forces are amply provided with food and clothing, and the public is urged not to include such matter in gift parcels. Not more than one Christmas parcel or package shall be accepted for mailing in any one week when sent by or on behalf of the same person or concern to or for the same addressee.

Preparation.—Owing to the great distance this mail must be transported and the handling and any storage it must undergo, it is absolutely necessary that all articles be packed in substantial boxes or containers and be covered with wrappers of sufficient strength not only to resist pressure of other mail in the same sack, but to withstand the weight of other sacks of mail, which in the long transit may be piled thereon. Furthermore, as each parcel is subject to censorship, delay in handling may be minimized by securing the covering of the parcel so as to permit ready inspection of the contents.

Many combination packages will probably be made up, including miscellaneous toilet articles, hard candies, soaps, etc. The contents of such packages should be tightly packed, in order that the several articles may not be loosened in transit, damaging the contents of the parcel itself or causing damage to the covering of the parcel. Christmas boxes should be inclosed in substantial containers. Candies in thin pasteboard boxes should be inclosed in wood, metal, or corrugated pasteboard. Sealed packages of candy, cigars, tobacco, and toilet articles in simplest mercantile form may be inclosed within parcels without affecting the parcel-post classification of such packages. Sharp-pointed or sharp-edged instruments, such as razors, knives, etc., must have their points or edges protected so they cannot cut through their coverings and damage other mail or injure postal employees.

Perishable matter.—No perishable matter should be included in any parcels.

Prohibited articles.—Intoxicants, inflammable materials (including matches of all kinds and lighter fluids), and poisons, or compositions which may kill or injure another, or damage the mails, are unmailable.

How to address parcels.—Addresses must be legible. Parcels addressed to overseas Army personnel should show, in addition to the name and address of the sender, the name, rank, Army serial number, branch of service, organization, A. P. O. number of the addressee and the post office through which the parcels are to be routed, as, for instance:

Parcels for naval personnel should show, in addition to the name and address of the sender, the name, rank, or rating of the addressee and the naval unit to which he is assigned, or name of ship, and post office through which the parcels are to be routed, as, for instance:

(Naval Unit or Vessel),

Parcels for members of the U. S. Marine Corps should show the rank or rating, full name and U. S. M. C., U. S. Marine Corps Unit No. — (insert appropriate No.); c/o Postmaster, New York, N. Y. or San Francisco, Calif. (as instructed by correspondent) for any Marine Corps Unit located overseas, as for instance:

Units located within the continental limits of the United States may be addressed direct, using name, rank, organization and location.

Postage.—Postage must be fully prepaid, the rate on parcels of fourth-class matter (that is, parcels exceeding 8 ounces) being the zone rate applicable from the post office where mailed to the post office in care of which the parcels are addressed. The third-class rate of 1½ cents for each 2 ounces applies to packages not exceeding 8 ounces, except in the case of books, on which the rate is 1 cent for each 2 ounces. Parcels containing only books conforming to the requirements prescribed therefor are acceptable at the special rate of 3 cents a pound. Stickers or labels resembling postage stamps are not permissible on the outside of parcels.

Permissible additions.—In addition to the name and address of the sender, which is required, inscriptions such as "Merry Christmas," "Please do not open until Christmas," "Happy New Year," "With best wishes," and the like, may be placed on the covering of the parcel in such manner as not to interfere with the address, or on a card inclosed therewith. Books may bear simple dedicatory inscriptions not of a nature of personal correspondence.

Insurance and registry services.—Mails should be advised to insure their Christmas gifts of more than ordinary value. However, it should be suggested that articles of considerable value, especially those of small size, be sealed and sent as first-class registered mail.

Use of money orders.—Postmasters should recommend to the public the use of postal money orders to transmit gifts of money to members of the armed forces outside the continental United States. With regard to cash remittances, patrons should be informed that at many places where such forces are stationed there is a local prohibition against the importation of United States money, and it could not be used if received. However, domestic postal money orders can be cashed at A. P. O.'s wherever they are located, and they are paid in local foreign currency at the rate of exchange in effect on the date the orders are presented.

Publicity.—Postmasters should give wide publicity to the foregoing through newspapers, radio, etc. (Postal Bulletin No. 18478, August 19, 1942.)

IMPROPER ACCEPTANCE OF COTTON BOLLS, INCLUDING SEEDS FOR PLANTING, ADDRESSED TO PLACES IN CALIFORNIA

Novelty packages containing cotton bolls, including seeds for planting, are being distributed to merchants for resale, and are being improperly accepted in the mails at various places, without certification, for delivery in California, in contravention of the provisions of the law embodied in section 596, P. L. and R.

The attention of postmasters is, therefore, invited to the notice regarding California plant quarantines published on pages 23 to 25 of the May 1937 Supplement to the Postal Guide. Cotton bolls, seed cotton, and cottonseed are entirely prohibited entry into California from any pest-infested area of the United States and must be accompanied with a certificate of inspection from any noninfested area.

In this connection attention is also invited to the notice published in the December 1941 Supplement to the Postal Guide, relating to Arizona plant quarantines, which prohibit or restrict the entry into that State of cotton bolls and cottonseed. (Postal Bulletin No. 18487, Sept. 9, 1942.)

OREGON STATE PLANT QUARANTINES

(Revision of Notice dated September 11, 1940)

Postal Bulletin 18032—September 17, 1940

Under plant quarantines and regulations issued by the State of Oregon the shipment into that State of certain plants and plant material known to be hosts of injurious pests and plant diseases is subject to certain restrictions, or entirely prohibited.

The following table gives a summary of the Oregon quarantine laws and regulations, showing the quarantined areas, the plants and plant products affected, and the pests and diseases of which such plants are known hosts. Under the provisions of paragraph 2 (b), section 596, Postal Laws and Regulations, postmasters should not accept such plants and plant products when presented for mailing in violation of these quarantine laws and regulations, and should invite the attention of the mailers thereto.

Shippers desiring Oregon permits must make application therefor direct to the Division of Plant Industry, State Department of Agriculture, Salem, Oreg.

Postmasters at places in Oregon where State inspection of plants and plant products is maintained under the Terminal Inspection Act should take the action prescribed by paragraph 4 (b), section 596, Postal Laws and Regulations, if par-

cels sent to such offices for terminal inspection are found to be in violation of these plant quarantine laws or regulations. (Postal Bulletin No. 18479, August 21, 1942).

DIVISION OF MONEY ORDERS

COMPLETE ADDRESS MUST BE GIVEN ON ADVICES OF IRISH MONEY ORDERS

The Money Order Exchange Office reports that it has been necessary to withhold from certification as many as 138 items intended for inclusion in a single money order list to Ireland because issuing employees have failed to enter on the money order advices the full and complete addresses of the payees.

Although the necessity for entering all essential details of payees' addresses on money order advices has been repeatedly brought to the attention of issuing personnel, the large number of items reported by the exchange office indicates that Departmental instructions are being disregarded.

Postmasters are directed, therefore, to see that all employees assigned to the issue of international money orders are thoroughly conversant with the requirements of the service in this connection and that in future the applications for money orders be carefully reviewed and held for further details unless they show the following:

The payee's full name. (At least one initial.)

The correct name of paying office. (Consult Form XIV.)

The name of the street and number of the house, if in a city.

The name of the county in which the office is located. (Postal Bulletin No. 18478, August 19, 1942.)

CHANGES AFFECTING MONEY-ORDER BUSINESS ONLY

Correction

Postmasters having in their files coupons of any such orders should be careful in certifying to applications for duplicates and warrants, or in answering inquiries regarding payment.

MONEY ORDERS ISSUED AT A. P. O. OR U. S. NAVAL VESSEL BRANCHES

TREATMENT IF DEFECTIVE OR IRREGULAR

Many postmasters receive defective money orders issued at A. P. O. branches or United States naval vessels and return them with Form 6518 addressed to the branch. Also many postmasters who cash money orders not drawn on their office and issued at A. P. O. branches or United States naval vessels send Form 6126 to the branch.

The records of the Army post office and United States naval vessel branches are sent promptly to the main office to which the branch is attached, and, therefore, **postmasters should return a defective money order to the main office** where it will be treated as repaid and reimbursement made by means of a check drawn on the Treasurer of the United States. **Likewise, Form 6126 should be sent to the main office** (not the branch) and the money order held as a suspended item until the reply coupon is received. Because of war conditions, the records are often not received promptly at the main office and such cases should be held for a reasonable

length of time before reporting them to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Money Orders. (Postal Bulletin No. 18484, Sept. 2, 1942.)

REGISTER OF MONEY ORDER POST OFFICES

NO EDITION FOR 1942

There will be no edition of the Register of Money Order Post Offices this year, and the 1941 Register should be used in drawing money orders payable in the foreign countries with which business is conducted on the domestic basis (Canada, Canal Zone, Cuba, etc.).

In issuing **domestic** money orders payable in the United States, however, postmasters shall refer to the **State List** of the Official Postal Guide for 1941 (pages 249 to 628, inclusive) when the name of a United States post office must be verified.

It seems that in issuing domestic money orders some postmasters are still using the Register of Money Order Post Offices of 1932. **The 1932 edition was the last one to contain United States money-order offices** and obviously it is not to be relied upon now in issuing either domestic or semidomestic money orders, and **all copies of the 1932 Register now on hand should be destroyed.** (Postal Bulletin No. 18474, Aug. 10, 1942.)

MONEY ORDER FEES

PAYMENT BY DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE THROUGH USE OF FORM 1034

From field agents of certain agencies of the Department of Agriculture, namely, the Farm Credit Administration, the Farm Security Administration, the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation, and the Soil Conservation Service, postmasters need no longer require Standard Form 1034 (Public Voucher for Purchases, etc.) in lieu of fees for money orders.

The agents (so-called field supervisors, county rural rehabilitation supervisors, county crop insurance supervisors, etc.) have instructions to purchase money orders daily for all cash received. They will make themselves known by means of an identification card. When the amount presented is more than \$100, the postmaster shall issue the required number of money orders for \$100 each and one money order for the remainder less than \$100. Only one application need be completed for the entire amount of money presented at one time.

All money orders issued to those agents shall be drawn **payable to the Treasurer of the United States and to no one else.** All such orders shall be drawn upon the postmaster of the city in which the fiscal (or regional) office serving the State is located.

The regular fee shall be charged for each money order, but instead of receiving payment in cash, the postmaster shall keep the remitter's receipt, on the back of which the field agent will sign his name and designate the fiscal (or regional) office to which Form 1034 shall be sent for payment.

At the end of each month the postmaster shall prepare one voucher on Form 1034 with three copies **for the total** amount of all the orders issued for each agency of the Department of Agriculture during the month, care being taken to see that the amount claimed on each Form 1034 is the exact total of all the receipts in the possession of the postmaster for such money orders issued during the month. The original Form 1034, accompanied by the duplicate and triplicate **and the receipts** for the orders, shall be forwarded in a penalty envelope to the fiscal office named on the back of the receipts. The quadruplicate should be retained by the postmaster as a memorandum of the transaction until a check drawn on the Treasurer of the United States is received in payment.

This change shall become effective September 1, 1942, and modifies previous instructions.

DIVISION OF STAMPS

DISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL MIGRATORY BIRD HUNTING REGULATIONS FOLDERS FOR 1942

Postmasters at all post offices having migratory-bird hunting stamps on sale will be furnished at an early date with an initial supply of folders entitled "Fed-

eral Migratory-Bird Hunting Regulations 1942," containing official information of importance to hunters concerning the open seasons, bag limits, etc., of various kinds of migratory game birds.

Each purchaser of one or more \$1 migratory-bird hunting stamps now on sale will be entitled to receive one of these folders at the time the stamps are bought. Purchasers of multiple lots of the stamps may, upon request, be furnished a corresponding number of folders. For this purpose, postmasters will see that each window clerk having a fixed-credit in migratory-bird hunting stamps is issued a supply of the folders on a basis of the local sales requirements. These employees shall also be properly instructed in regard to the distribution of the folders.

Since the distribution of the folders to post offices could not be effected prior to July 1, when the new series of migratory-bird hunting stamps was placed on sale, postmasters are authorized to honor, so far as possible, requests for the folders from patrons who purchased stamps prior to the receipt of the post office supply of folders. Patrons, other than purchasers of migratory-bird hunting stamps, who apply for copies of the folder, should be referred to the Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington, D. C., unless the postmaster has a surplus supply, in which case such applications may be honored at the local post office.

Postmasters requiring additional supplies of the folders may obtain same on application to the central-accounting postmaster, except postmasters at offices in Maryland, Virginia, and West Virginia, who will submit such applications to the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Building Operations and Supplies, Equipment and Supplies Branch, Washington, D. C.

DIVISION OF POSTAL SAVINGS

WAR SAVINGS BONDS AND STAMPS

Window Displays

The War Savings Staff of the Treasury Department has arranged for the manufacture of new displays for War Savings bond and stamp windows. Post offices that sell both bonds and stamps and those that sell only stamps will receive material suitable to their needs. It is understood that the distribution to first-class offices has been completed and that rapid progress is being made in supplying other offices. The new material should be put on display as soon as received and the old treated as waste postal material.

These window displays are being shipped to every post office, and any postmaster who does not receive a set or needs an additional supply should advise the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Postal Savings. (Postal Bulletin No. 18477, August 17, 1942.)

POSTAL SAVINGS

Change of Address of Statistical Report, Form PS 541

Postmasters at all postal-savings depositories shall hereafter send their monthly postal-savings statistical reports, Form PS 541, to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Postal Savings, Washington, D. C., beginning with the report for August. Until revised forms with the new address are received, the cards on hand shall be used and the address changed. These reports shall be submitted immediately after the close of each month.

Form PS 541 C/A has been discontinued and the stock at central depository offices may be disposed of as waste postal material. (Postal Bulletin No. 18478, August 19, 1942.)

DIVISION OF REGISTERED MAILS

WAR SAVINGS BONDS

Bulk Billing

Postmasters are advised that a number of the larger offices have been authorized to bulk-bill registered letters containing War Savings Bonds of the E series when

contained in jackets or rotary-lock pouches made up direct for the offices to which the registered letters are sent. The manifold bills accompanying the registered articles are indorsed to show the series of registration numbers, the name of the dispatching office, and the total number of articles dispatched. In case it is necessary to ascertain further particulars should a registered article in the series be unaccounted for on the delivery records of the post office to which the registered letters are sent, the name and address of the addressee may be obtained from the dispatching post office.

Postmasters receiving bulk-billed dispatches of these bonds should record the articles on the local registry forms, any letter prefix appearing on the articles in conjunction with the registration numbers being recorded on the delivery record and delivery receipts.

Postmasters authorized to bulk-bill these mailings have also been permitted to postmark the articles once over the flap or to run the articles through the canceling machine for postmarking purposes; to include the office of mailing in the meter indicia; and to place the meter indicia on the face of the articles without being required to overcancel the meter indicia. (Postal Bulletin No. 18476, August 14, 1942).

WAR SAVINGS BONDS AND WAR SAVINGS STAMPS—BILLING TO REGISTRY SECTION

It appears that at some of the larger offices registered letters containing War Savings Bonds are listed on manifold bills, before being turned over to the registry section, to show the individual registration numbers of the articles. Where practicable these letters should be listed on the manifold bill by number to number inclusive, thus saving the time and labor of recording individual registration numbers.

Postmasters at offices authorized to furnish other postmasters, or local stations or branches, supplies of War Savings Bonds or Stamps, should bill such matter to the registry section by inclusive numbers when advantageous instead of listing each individual number. In this connection see notice published on pages 23 and 24 of the October 1940 Supplement to the Postal Guide under the caption "Method of Listing to Registry Section of Postage-Stamp Supplies Intended for District Post Offices or Local Stations and Branches." (Postal Bulletin No. 18476, August 14, 1942.)

The Following Notices Were Issued From the Bureau of the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General

VENDING MACHINES PROHIBITED

It has come to our attention that vending machines dispensing soft drinks, confections, etc., have been installed in a number of Government owned post-office buildings contrary to section 29, paragraph 1 of "Instructions and Suggestions for Postmasters in the Operation of Public Buildings, 1937," which prohibits the maintenance of vending machines in these buildings for the sale of tobacco products, beverages, confections, foodstuffs, or merchandise of any character. These regulations apply to post-office workrooms and swing rooms as well as to all portions of the building that may be occupied by other Federal agencies.

In view of the large number of vending machines on the market which offer for sale a great variety of merchandise, it would be impossible to allow all firms desiring the privilege to install their machines. If permission were granted one company, we could not consistently deny it to others because of the public nature of the building. Consequently, it is considered necessary to require strict adherence to the regulations cited and where vending machines are now installed, they must be removed promptly.

The foregoing does not apply to vending machines installed in authorized cafeterias operated on a nonprofit basis under the supervision of the First Assistant Postmaster General. (Postal Bulletin No. 18469, July 29, 1942.)

POSTER—"ALLIES FOR A BIG JOB—OCD"

Lobby Display Authorized

The Office of Civilian Defense will forward to all Postmasters during the month of August a poster entitled "Allies for a Big Job—OCD." The display of this poster in the lobbies of all post offices for a period of about 2 months from the time of receipt is authorized and it should be displayed in such manner as not to mar or deface the walls or woodwork. (Postal Bulletin No. 18472, August 5, 1942.)

ADJUSTMENTS IN SALARIES OF CUSTODIAL EMPLOYEES

To Postmasters Having Custody of Government-Owned Post-Office Buildings:

On August 1, 1942, the President approved H. R. 6217 (Public Law 694, 77th Cong.), "An act to amend section 13 of the Classification Act of 1923, as amended."

In conformance with this bill the compensation of charmen and charwomen is increased from 50 cents per hour to 65 cents per hour and the compensation of head charwomen from 55 cents to 70 cents per hour. Beginning August 1, 1942, therefore, all charmen, charwomen, substitute charmen, and substitute charwomen should be compensated at the rate of 65 cents per hour and all head charwomen at the rate of 70 cents per hour. All appointments beginning August 1, 1942, shall be at the new rate.

The legislation also provides for a minimum of \$1,500 per annum for watchmen or building guards. All custodial watchmen who are now receiving less than \$1,500 per annum should be paid at the rate of \$1,500 per annum beginning August 1, 1942. All appointments beginning August 1, 1942, shall be at the new rate.

A new minimum rate of \$1,200 per annum for custodial laborers is also provided for in the bill. All laborers receiving less than \$1,200 per annum should be increased to that rate effective August 1, 1942. All appointments beginning August 1, 1942, shall be at the rate of \$1,200 per annum.

Under the new bill elevator operators are allocated to grade 2, which has a minimum of \$1,200 per annum. All appointments beginning August 1, 1942, to positions of elevator operator must be at the rate of \$1,200 per annum.

If an employee is now receiving the minimum of the new range there shall be no change in his compensation. There shall also be no change in the compensation of employees appointed prior to August 1, 1942, who are receiving more than the new minimum rates.

Further detailed instructions concerning other custodial employees will be forwarded as early as possible. Please assist us by not making special inquiry. Do not submit forms BOM-62 reporting change in compensation. (Postal Bulletin No. 18475, August 12, 1942.)

DISPLAY OF GASOLINE RATIONING WINDSHIELD STICKERS ON GOVERNMENT-OWNED MAIL TRUCKS

The Office of Price Administration has advised the Department to the effect that it has come to its attention that certain automobiles belonging to several Governmental agencies and departments do not carry gasoline rationing windshield stickers as required by the regulations.

It being the desire of the Department to cooperate with the Office of Price Administration in this important matter, it will be appreciated if all postmasters concerned will see to it that the gasoline-rationing stickers be displayed on the windshield of each Government-owned mail truck. (Postal Bulletin No. 18477, August 17, 1942.)

U. S. MARITIME COMMISSION RECRUITING POSTER

Lobby Display Authorized

Postmasters are authorized to display in available space in post-office lobbies during the period of September 8 to 18, inclusive, 1942, a poster issued by the United States Maritime Commission designed to encourage the recruitment of seamen for the merchant marine. The poster should be displayed in such manner as not to mar or deface the walls or woodwork and should be removed at the end of the period stated. (Postal Bulletin No. 18477, August 17, 1942.)
