PARCELS POST—JAPANESE POST OFFICES IN CHINA.

January 3, 1907.

Order No. 6.

The Postal Administration of Japan having advised this Department that certain Japanese post offices—in addition to those named in Order No. 1293, dated October 13, 1906—have been authorized to transact international Parcels-Post service, it is hereby ordered that “parcels” addressed for delivery at the places named below shall, for the future, be admitted to the Parcels-Post mails made up in this country for Japan, at the postage rate and subject to the conditions applicable to “parcels” addressed for delivery in Japan, viz:

IN MANCHURIA:

Dairen (Talien), Riojun (Port Arthur), Riujuton (Liushutun), Kinshu (Chinchow), Furanten (Pulantien), Gwaboten

(Wafantien), Yugakujo (Hsiungyocheng), Gaihei (Kaiping), Daisekkio (Tashichiao), Mankarei (Wanchialing), Tokuriji (Telissu), Giukaton (Newchaturun), Kaijio (Haichaeng), Anzanten (Anshanchan), Rioyo (Liaoyang), Yendai (Yentai), Sokaton (Suchiatun), Hoten (Mikden), Shindashi (Hsintaitzu), Tetsurei (Tiehling), Kaigen (Kaiyuen), Shoto (Changtu), Sobyoshi (Shuangmiaotzu), Shiheigai (Ssupingchieh), Kakkaten (Kuechiatien), Kosherei (Kungchuling), Hankaton (Fanchiantun), Kanjoshi (Koautchensi), Shinminfu (Singmingfu), Senkinsai (Chienchinsai), Renzankan (Lieushankuan), Sokako (Tsahokow), Howojio (Fenghuangcheng), Antoken (Antung), Masankashi (Masanchiatzu), Honkeiko (Penhsiku) and Hishiko (Pitzuwo).

Order No. 1293 mentioned above is hereby modified accordingly.

6 *Conditions Applicable to Postal Cards of Foreign Origin.*

ARMS AND AMMUNITION IN MEXICAN MAILS.

January 19, 1907.

Order No. 40.

Upon advice received from the Postal Administration of Mexico, under date of the 11th instant, the prohibition to import arms and ammunition, except the regulation arms and ammunition of the Mexican army, into the States of Campeche and Yucatan, and the Territory of Quintana Roo, has been annulled; so that said prohibition now applies only to the State of Sonora and the Territory of Baja California.

Consequently, the second paragraph of my Order No. 1317, dated October 22, 1906, is hereby modified so as to direct Postmasters to decline to receive for mailing packages addressed for delivery at any place in the State of Sonora or in the Territory of Baja California, which contain arms or ammunition of any kind.

The regulation arms and ammunition of the Mexican army are specified in my Order No. 355a, dated April 14, 1905.

Postmasters will cause due notice of the foregoing to be taken at their offices.

CERTAIN PUBLICATIONS ADMITTED TO CANADIAN MAILS AT DOMESTIC POSTAGE RATES.

November 27, 1906.

The Postal Administration of Canada having advised this Department, under date of the 24th instant, that "Good Literature" and "The People's Home Journal," papers published at New York, N. Y., have been removed from the list of papers not entitled to transmission in Canadian mails at the publishers' rate of postage; the Postmaster-General has directed—with reference to his Order No. 767 of the 10th of March, 1906—that "Good Literature" and "The People's Home Journal" should now be admitted to the mails for Canada subject to our domestic postage rates and conditions.

CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO POSTAL CARDS OF FOREIGN ORIGIN.

November 27, 1906.

Referring to the Postmaster-General's Order No. 1338, dated October 31, 1906, directing that post cards conforming to the provisions of the Rome Convention when mailed in foreign countries and fully prepaid by postage stamps, shall be delivered to addressees in the United States without additional charge for postage;

postal officials are informed that the provisions of the Rome Convention above referred to are as follows:

1. Post cards must consist of paper or cardboard.
2. The left-hand half of the front of the card may be used for a message as well as the back of the card.
3. Photographs and engravings on very thin paper may be pasted on the back and on the left-half of the front of the card, provided they adhere *completely* to the card.
4. Private post cards need *not* bear the title "post card" or "postal card."

BOOKS OF ONE-CENT POSTAGE STAMPS.

January 15, 1907.

Postmasters are notified that preparations are being made to issue 1-cent postage stamps in book form, beginning about March 1, 1907. There will be only one size, containing twenty-four 1-cent stamps in four sheets of six-stamps each, interleaved with paraffin paper and bound like the books of 2-cent stamps. The selling price will be 25 cents per book.

Until a supply of revised requisition Forms No. 3203 can be furnished, postmasters desiring a supply of the books of 1-cent stamps will make requisition therefor on Form 3203 by interlining the number desired, and value thereof, above the items of books of 2-cent stamps. The smallest number issued to postmasters will be ten.

Postmasters are requested to cause an announcement to be published in the local press of the issue of 1-cent stamps in book form, if it can be done as a news item without expense to the Department.

REQUISITIONS FOR POSTAGE STAMPS.

January 22, 1907.

Postmasters are advised that postage stamps are put up in sealed packages containing, respectively, 10,000, 50,000 and 200,000 stamps of each denomination. Requisitions should, so far as possible, be made for these quantities, or their multiples, where it can be done within the amount of the postmaster's bond, and provided the stamps will be needed for legitimate postal business within a reasonable time. (See paragraphs 1, 2, and 3, section 331, P. L. & R.). For example, requisitions should be drawn for 10,000 2c stamps rather than 7,000, for 50,000 rather than 30,000, and for 200,000 rather than 170,000.

Where requisitions call for stamps in quantities other than as above indicated, this office will, in its discretion, increase or decrease the amounts furnished.

CARE IN FILLING INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDER ADVICES.

January 21, 1907.

The attention of postmasters at international money order offices is directed to the necessity for greater care in filling international money order advices. Models of international money order forms with instructions as to the proper method in drawing such orders will be found on pages 8 to 15 of the "International List," a copy of which has been furnished to every international money order office.

The transposition of advices is a frequent cause of complaint, the particulars of address of the payee of Order No. 1, being entered in Advice No. 2, and vice

versa. Errors of this character will be avoided if:

a) The application is numbered before the order is issued;

b) The advice is completed at the moment the order is issued.

Drawing the order and advice, coupon and receipt should be one operation; if, however, this is impracticable on account of pressure of business, the advice may be completed subsequently at leisure, by entering in ink the name and address of the payee, and name of remitter. In such case the particulars in the advice should be carefully compared, not only with the

application but with the coupon bearing the same number.

REGISTRY SYSTEM.

Provides for safe transmission and correct delivery.

U. S. Registered Mails go to every post office in the world.

Valuable mail matter of all kinds should be registered.

The registry fee is eight cents in addition to the postage, foreign or domestic rate.

Postmasters and other employees are at all times required to advise the registration of valuable mail matter.

Mail matter may be registered at any post office, or at any post office station. Letter carriers in cities will register letters in residential districts. Rural carriers will register letters and parcels throughout their routes.

Without extra cost, every registered letter (or parcel prepaid at the letter rate) registered at and addressed for delivery through a U. S. post office, is insured against loss for its value not to exceed twenty-five dollars.

Full instructions concerning the Registry System are published in Title V, Postal Laws and Regulations, Edition of 1902, and in the annual and monthly U. S. Postal Guides. They must be carefully read and fully complied with.

THE REVISED EDITION OF THE

PAMPHLET OF GENERAL POSTAL INFORMATION

IS NOW READY FOR DISTRIBUTION.

Postmasters who have not received a supply of the revised edition or whose supply is getting low, should at once make application to the Third Assistant Postmaster-General, for the estimated number required, giving the approximate number of families and business concerns served by their offices, together with an estimate of the whole population within their postal jurisdiction; also the number of rural routes emanating from their offices.

The pamphlet is issued under authority of an act of Congress. It contains the classification, conditions, and postage rates for domestic and foreign mail matter. It is for *free* distribution to the public through postmasters.
