Amendments to the Postal Laws and Regulations.

PASTES, SALVES, ETC., IN THE MAILS.

December 4, 1907.

Order No. 909.

Section 496 of the Postal Laws and Regulations (edition of 1902) is hereby amended as follows:

Add to paragraph 2 the following sub-paragraph:

(c) Pastes, salves, etc., not easily liquefiable (not exceeding four ounces, liquid measure), when inclosed in water-tight tin boxes with screw-top lids, may be placed in a box of thick corrugated pasteboard, and then well wrapped with strong paper and tied with twine.

SALARY PAYMENTS—PREPARATION OF POSTMASTERS.

January 23, 1908.

Order No. 1029.

Paragraph 9 of section 385, Postal Laws and Regulations of 1902, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9. Postmasters must be prepared to pay salaries semi-monthly within three days (including Sundays and holidays) after the expiration of the fifteenth and last day of the month, except when both a Sunday and a holiday fall within said three days, in which event the period within which payments shall be made may be extended one day. Whenever the postal funds of the office are not sufficient to make such payments transfers should be made from the money-order to the postal account. If the available postal and money-order funds combined are insufficient for this purpose, application should be made on Form 3011 to the Third Assistant Postmaster-General, who will cause an accountable warrant to be issued for the sum needed. Form 3011 may be obtained upon requisition to the Third Assistant Postmaster-General.

See sections 1396, 1397 and 1402 as to salaries of officers of the Railway Mail Service and postal clerks.

THE RENOMINATION OF THE PRESIDENT—ACTIVITY OF POSTAL EMPLOYEES.

December 11, 1907.

Order No. 921.

ORDERED, The following communication from the President is published for the information and guidance of officers and

employees of this Department and the Postal Service:

“THE WHITE HOUSE,

“WASHINGTON, Nov. 19, 1907.

“I have been informed that certain office-holders in your Department are proposing to go to the National Convention as delegates in favor of renominating me

for the Presidency, or are proposing to procure my endorsement for such renomination by State Conventions. This must not be. I wish you to inform such officers as you may find it advisable or necessary to inform in order to carry out the spirit of this instruction, that such advocacy of my renomination, or acceptance of an election as delegate for that purpose, will be regarded as a serious violation of official propriety and will be dealt with accordingly.

LOTTERY SCHEME.

Fraud Order No. 1023, dated January 21, 1908, was issued against the Banca Norocul and J. Leipziger, at Bucharest, Roumania.

The following order was issued from the bureau of the First Assistant Postmaster-General — F. H. Hitchcock, First Assistant:

MAIL CHUTES UNDER CARE AND CUSTODY OF POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT.

November 30, 1907.

Order No. 896.

ORDERED, That, whereas the Security Mail Chute, manufactured by the United States Mail Chute Equipment Company of Saint Louis, Mo., appears to conform to the present requirements, it is declared in accordance with the Act of Congress approved January 23, 1893, that in all mailing apparatus of this style heretofore installed, or to be installed hereafter, under the regulations of the Department, the chute shall be considered a part of the receiving boxes and shall be under the exclusive care and custody of the Post Office Department.

The following instructions were issued from the bureau of the Second Assistant Postmaster-General — J. T. McCleary, Second Assistant:

PARCEL-POST PACKAGES INSECURELY WRAPPED.

December 31, 1907.

The Department has been advised that more than 25 per cent. of the Parcel-Post packages destined for foreign countries reach the United States exchange offices of despatch in bad condition — the covers broken or untied and the Customs Declarations detached, the damaged condition being due apparently to carelessness in preparing the parcels for mailing.

In order to prevent such damage, postmasters are hereby directed to refuse to receive any package presented for mailing by Parcel-Post which is not securely and substantially packed so that it can be safely transported in ordinary mail sacks, as required by section 286, on page 708, of the Postal Guide for January, 1907.

PARCEL-POST PACKAGES FOR MEXICO.

January 13, 1908.

Referring to the circular dated December 29, 1898, on page 1107 of the United States Official Postal Guide for January, 1899, relative to parcel-post packages for Mexico; United States postal officials are informed that the Postal Administration of Mexico has advised this Department that, *commencing* on the 15th of January, 1908, parcel-post packages weighing up to eleven (11) pounds (5 kilograms) may be sent to the following Mexican post offices, viz.:

Coeneo State of Michoacan;
Paraje State of Veracruz; and
Boquillas del Cermen, State of Coahuila.

Consequently, parcel-post packages weighing not more than eleven pounds may, on and after the date named, be accepted for mailing to the Mexican post offices above named as well as to the Mexican post offices named on pages 711-713 of the United States Official Postal Guide for January, 1907.

PARCEL-POST PACKAGES FOR AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND.

December 2, 1907.

Parcel-post packages for Australia and New Zealand must be forwarded invariably to San Francisco, Cal., for despatch. It is reported such packages are at times improperly sent to Seattle, Wash., thereby involving serious delay in transmission.

SAMOAN ISLANDS — MAILS FOR.

January 21, 1908.

Hereafter articles for the Samoan Islands will be forwarded for dispatch by steamers sailing from San Francisco and advertised to call at Samoa. Otherwise all such articles will be forwarded exclusively for dispatch via Vancouver, B. C., unless specially addressed for dispatch via some other route. General Order 644 is modified accordingly.

MAIL FOR WAR VESSELS STATIONED AT VARIOUS POINTS IN THE PACIFIC.

December 2, 1907.

Referring to notice published in Daily Bulletin of January 30, 1907, relative to mails for war vessels stationed in the Pacific, it is further directed that any such mails addressed for transmission through the Seattle or Tacoma offices shall also be made up separately and not included with the city mails for the post offices mentioned.

INTOXICATING LIQUORS SHALL NOT BE TRANSPORTED BY CONTRACTORS OR MESSENGERS WHILE ON DUTY.

January 4, 1908.

Order No. 979.

It is hereby ordered that it shall be a condition of any contract hereafter entered into for carrying the mails upon star, screen-wagon, mail-messenger, or special-service route that the contractor or carrier shall not transport intoxicating liquors from one point to another upon such route while in the performance of mail service.

The following orders and notices were issued from the bureau of the Third Assistant Postmaster-General — A. L. Lawshe, Third Assistant:

SALE OF JAMESTOWN STAMPS TO BE CONTINUED.

January 20, 1908.

The instructions in announcement dated March 25, 1907, published on page 13 of the April supplement to the 1907 Postal Guide, directing postmasters not to sell postage stamps of the Jamestown commemorative issue after November 30, 1907, and the supplementary instructions to the same effect on page 10 of the October supplement, are hereby rescinded. Postmasters having any of the Jamestown stamps remaining on hand are directed to continue their sale until the supply is exhausted. These stamps should not, however, be forced upon purchasers who prefer the regular issue.

The Department has a limited supply of the Jamestown stamps (1-cent, 2-cent and 5-cent), which will be issued to postmasters desiring them. Requisition should be made on Form 3201, writing a large, plain capital letter "C" (standing for "Commemorative") under the

printed word "County" on the blank. Requisitions will not be filled for less than a full sheet of 100 of each denomination desired.

STAMPED ENVELOPE PRODUCTION
NOW CURRENT WITH ORDERS.

January 1, 1908.

Postmasters are notified that the Department is now prepared to fill promptly all requisitions for special-request and plain stamped envelopes, the contractor having brought the work of the factory practically to date.

Postmasters may notify regular users of special-request envelopes that orders are now being filled within the usual time.

NEW POSTAL CARD.

December 31, 1907.

1. Postmasters and the postal service are notified that a new postal card, known as the "McKinley No. 3" design, is now ready for issue.

2. The size of the new card, $3\frac{1}{4}$ by $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches, is the same as that of the "McKinley No. 2" card, as also is its design, except that a vertical line appears approximately one-third the distance from the left end of the address side of the card, providing a space in which messages may be written in accordance with the Postmaster General's Order No. 539, dated July 13, 1907, pages 6 and 7 of the August Supplement to the 1907 Postal Guide.

3. To secure supplies of the "McKinley No. 3" postal card, postmasters will make requisition on Form 3201, writing "No. 3" above the word "McKinley" on the blank.

4. Requisitions for the new postal card will be filled in the order in which they reach the Department; they will not be expedited. It is possible the initial de-

mand may be so heavy that shipments can not be made promptly, and it may become necessary to cut down the quantities called for in requisitions. This is stated so that postmasters will understand the reason for any delay or reduction of their requisitions, and avoid unnecessary correspondence on the subject.

5. The regular "McKinley No. 2" postal cards are not to be withdrawn from sale at post offices. They will continue to be issued to postmasters on requisitions which do not indicate that the new "McKinley No. 3" card is desired.

INTERNATIONAL REPLY-COUPONS.

December 10, 1907.

1. Postmasters are hereby notified that the following countries and colonies have arranged to participate in the exchange of international reply-coupons in addition to those listed in section 1 of the announcement dated September 26, 1907, published on pages 10 to 12 of the October supplement to the 1907 Postal Guide:

French post offices in China.
Italy and the Italian Colonies.
Netherlands Guiana.

2. Referring to section 14 of the announcement of September 26, 1907, as to redemption of the international reply-coupons issued by foreign countries, postmasters are directed to forward the redeemed reply-coupons to this office as promptly as possible after the close of each quarter. The redeemed reply-coupons should be arranged by countries of issue before being forwarded to this office.

ERRORS IN POSTMASTERS' RECORDS
OF PAID MONEY ORDERS.

The attention of this office has been drawn by the auditor to the frequency of errors by postmasters in transmitting to

his office as invalid, advices of money orders which have been paid or repaid. Of the entire number of advices returned as invalid during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1907, approximately one in every seven represented a paid order on file as a voucher. Such errors entail much additional labor directed mainly to the protection of the careless officials, who might otherwise be subjected to loss in the event of a double payment resulting from erroneous certification of an application for duplicate or warrant.

Other related errors are committed in transmitting advices of unpaid orders to the auditor *before*, or in retaining them *after* expiration of the full period of validity. A money order issued on February 1, 1907, may be paid at any time before March 1, 1908. (Section 1035, Postal Laws and Regulations.)

After payment of an order, the date of payment must be stamped immediately on the corresponding advice, and record of the transaction completed. (Section 1005.) After repayment, the issuing postmaster must at once recall the advice from the office drawn upon, complete his record and forward the repaid order, and advice, as vouchers, to the auditor. (Sections 1021 and 1128.)

Monthly statements of unpaid orders more than one year old, accompanied by the invalid advices, are to be made to the auditor, in conformity with section 1132 of the regulations.

Postmasters at money order offices are enjoined to observe great care in keeping records of paid orders.

**SURPLUS FUNDS — POSTMASTERS
MUST CONFORM STRICTLY TO
POSTAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS
IN MAKING REMITTANCES.**

January 23, 1908.

Complaints have reached the Department of late relative to the frequency

of errors made by postmasters at the smaller offices in remitting surplus funds to their depositories, the errors being often of such a nature as to entail much extra clerical labor and engender disputes as to the amount remitted.

Attention is therefore hereby drawn to sections 366, 367, 369, 801, 838, 1109, 1110 and 1111 of the Postal Laws and Regulations,—particularly to paragraph 1 of section 366, paragraphs 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 and 13 of section 367, and paragraphs 5, 6 and 7 of section 1110,—and remitting postmasters are cautioned to follow strictly the instructions therein given, taking care to use the proper form of letter of transmittal (Form 3044 or 3044A for postal funds and Form 6021 for money order funds), to give therein an accurate description of the money remitted, and to see that the total amount named in the letter of transmittal is neither more nor less than the amount actually enclosed; that the envelope (No. 47) is properly addressed and securely sealed, and, in the case of a remittance in currency, that the letter is forwarded *by registered mail*, without postage or registration fee.

Postmasters at depository post offices are requested to report to the Department cases of habitual carelessness on the part of remitting postmasters.

**NEW STYLE CUBAN MONEY ORDER
AND ADVICE FORMS.**

January 25, 1908.

On January 1, 1908, the Cuban Postal Administration put into use in all money order offices in Cuba a new style money order and advice form. With some variations these new forms are in practical accord with the forms now in use in this country, the instructions governing the payment of which may, generally speaking, be applied to the treatment of Cuban

orders. The amount is expressed both in figures and words, the latter being in the Spanish language; postmasters should, therefore, consult the table of numerals in foreign languages on page 151 of the current Register of Money Order Post Offices. It should be noted that the amount in Cuban orders is stated in "pesos" and "centavos," which are equivalent in value to "dollars" and "cents" in United States currency.

Special attention is also called to the fact that the Cuban Postal Administration has forbidden its postmasters to accept any money order that contains an alteration, correction, or erasure. Postmasters in this country are, therefore, particularly enjoined to exercise the greatest care in drawing orders for payment in Cuba, and to refrain from attempting to correct, by subsequent change, an error made in the issue of such an order. In this connection, see sections 988 and 993 of the Postal Laws and Regulations.

NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF PAYEES OF ORDERS PAYABLE IN ITALY.

January 23, 1908.

The Italian Postal Administration has brought to the attention of this Department that delay in payment of money orders drawn on Italy is frequently caused by a defective or insufficient designation of the payee, or of the place of residence.

The name and address should be stated precisely as on the envelope of a letter dispatched through the mails. Remitters should be notified that unless the particulars of address furnished by them are such as to identify the payee beyond a doubt, delay in payment may ensue, or possibly wrong payment.

Italian remitters should be required to state, not only the name of the post office

and the province in which it is situated, but the name of the village or rural commune in which the payee may reside; if the payee lives in a city the street and number must be given; if the payee is a woman, it should be indicated whether she is married or single (Mrs. or Miss, Signora or Signorina). The payee's name should be given as fully as possible: Christian name, surname, and paternity. The designation of the father's name is desired by the Italian postal authorities, as a means of identification of the intended beneficiary. It is sometimes the only means of ascertaining the true payee when there are several persons bearing the same name.

Care should be exercised in copying the names to distinguish between masculine and feminine appellations; for instance:

Giovanni = John
Giovanna = Jane
Giuseppe = Joseph
Giuseppa = Josephine
Francesco = Francis
Francesca = Frances

Attention is directed to the "Equivalents in foreign languages of words commonly used in money order business" printed on page 152 of the Register of Money Order Offices.

FEES DEDUCTED BY SWITZERLAND ON INDIRECT EXCHANGE.

January 22, 1908.

Postmasters at international money order offices will please note under the head of "Indirect Exchange," in the Postal Guide for January, 1908, that the fee deducted by the Swiss Post Office Department on money orders exchanged through its agency between the United States on one hand, and Roumania and Servia on the other, is 25 centimes for each sum of fifty francs or fraction thereof.

ORIGINAL NUMBERS OF REGISTERED LETTERS AND PARCELS TO BE PLACED IN UPPER LEFT-HAND CORNER OF ENVELOPE OR WRAPPER.

January 9, 1908.

In numbering registered letters and parcels, particularly those addressed for delivery in foreign countries, postmasters will cause the *original number* of the letter or parcel (that is, the number shown by the window receipt issued to the sender, or the main office *dispatching* number given matter registered by city or rural carriers) to be placed in the upper left-hand portion of the address side of the registered piece, immediately under, or a little to the right of, the name and address of the sender.

This requirement is necessary in order that foreign offices receiving registered pieces may readily distinguish the original number from any other numbers appearing on the letters and parcels, and thus quickly identify the pieces by their original numbers.

CUBA.—CHANGE IN SCHEME GOVERNING DISPATCH OF REGISTERED MAIL FOR CUBA.

January 22, 1908.

Hereafter postmasters in the States and counties enumerated below will dispatch to Chicago, Ill., as the proper exchange office,* instead of to Jacksonville, Fla., all registered matter addressed for delivery in Cuba. The schemes printed on pages 778 to 782, inclusive, of the January, 1907, and on pages 96 to 101, inclusive, of the January, 1908, Official Postal Guides, are modified accordingly:

UNAUTHORIZED NOT-REGULAR DISPATCHES TO R. P. O.'S OR TERMINAL R. P. O.'S.

January 25, 1908.

The attention of all postmasters concerned is directed to the fact that the general extension of the authorization for not-regular dispatches of inner registered sacks, published on pages 14, 15 and 16 of the November, 1907, and on pages 80, 81, 82 and 83 of the January, 1908, Postal Guide, does not authorize such dispatches to R. P. O.'s or Terminal R. P. O.'s.

The R. P. O. through registered pouch service and the R. P. O. inner registered sack service use a special form of rotary-lock; and R. P. O.'s and Terminal R. P. O.'s are not supplied with the ordinary rotary-lock keys. Postmasters therefore must not make dispatches to R. P. O.'s or Terminal R. P. O.'s unless they are specifically authorized to do so by the Third Assistant Postmaster-General; and when they are specifically authorized, the dispatches must invariably be made under

the R. M. S. or blue locks, and not under the locks which are used in dispatches of ordinary through registered pouches and inner registered sacks.

If inner registered sacks or through registered pouches labeled to an R. P. O. or a Terminal R. P. O. are erroneously dispatched under ordinary rotary-locks, the sacks or pouches should be opened in the R. P. O. or Terminal R. P. O. addressed, in the manner prescribed by section 1459 of the Postal Laws and Regulations for the treatment of registered sacks and pouches received under a damaged or defective lock, by filing or cutting the staple, if practicable; otherwise by cutting the strap; and proper distribution should then be made of the contents, in order to avoid delay.

WRITTEN DESIGNATION OF NUMBER OF PIECES IN PACKAGE OF THIRD-CLASS MATTER PERMISSIBLE ON MATTER ITSELF OR WRAPPER THEREOF.

January 18, 1908.

Under section 478 of the Postal Laws and Regulations a written designation of the number of pieces or articles contained in a package of third-class matter is a permissible inscription to place on the matter itself or on the wrapper covering the same.

The following notices were issued from the bureau of the Fourth Assistant Postmaster-General — P. V. DeGraw, Fourth Assistant:

NAME OF POST OFFICE, COUNTY AND STATE, MUST BE PLACED ON ALL CORRESPONDENCE WITH, AND REPORTS TO, THE DEPARTMENT.

January 20, 1908.

The failures by postmasters to imprint postmarking stamps on, or to include

name of post office, county and state, in the various reports rendered in connection with the rural delivery service and communications to this bureau, have grown so numerous of late as to result in serious embarrassment and detriment to the service, as it is sometimes impossible to identify a post office by a postmaster's name, and great loss of time is entailed.

The Department insists on a strict observance by postmasters of section 272, Postal Laws and Regulations, and Article 555, January, 1907, Postal Guide, which require that the name of post office, county and state, shall be written, imprinted or stamped on all official correspondence with, or reports to, the Department.

FACING SLIPS TO RAILWAY POSTAL CLERKS AND TO THIRD AND FOURTH CLASS POSTMASTERS.

December 23, 1907.

The practice of forwarding printed facing slips to railway postal clerks and to postmasters at offices of the third and fourth classes under penalty labels by the Feist Printing Company will on and after February 1, 1908, be discontinued.

Railway postal clerks and postmasters at offices of the third and fourth classes may obtain from the contractor, the Feist Printing Company, White Haven, Pa., printed facing slips at their own expense, including the necessary transportation charges.

USE OF JUTE TWINE.

The attention of all employees is invited to Order No. 386 issued by the Postmaster-General May 29, 1907, which reads as follows:

"All employees in the Postal Service are hereby directed to exercise the greatest economy in the use of jute twine in

making up packages of letters. In tying packages twine only sufficient for security should be used, and its removal at points of destination should be made in such manner as to render possible its further use."

In acknowledgment of the order many postmasters have reported the adoption of methods under which they have been able to save sufficient twine from pack-

ages received at their offices to meet their requirements in the dispatch of mail. This information has been very gratifying to the Postmaster-General, who desires that the importance of Order No. 386 be emphasized in the hope that every possible precaution may be availed of to obviate unnecessary waste in the use of twine.

Remittances of Surplus Postal Funds

The attention of the Department has been called to the fact that a large number of postmasters remit their surplus postal funds to the Auditor for the Post Office Department, instead of to their designated depositaries. THIS PRACTICE MUST BE DISCONTINUED.

In this connection the attention of postmasters is directed to section 364 of the Postal Laws and Regulations, which states that postmasters **MUST NOT** remit their surplus postal funds to the Post Office Department, nor to the Auditor for the Post Office Department.
