The following orders and notices were issued from the office of the Postmaster General — G. v.L. Meyer, Postmaster General.

AMENDMENT TO THE POSTAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

THIRD AND FOURTH CLASS MATTER.

Order No. 1723.

SEPTEMBER 10, 1908.

Section 483½, paragraphs 6 and 7 of the Postal Laws and Regulations, edition of 1902, is hereby amended, effective October 1, 1908, to read as follows:

6. A receipt (Form 3603) for each mailing must be issued by the postmaster to the sender. This receipt must show the class of matter mailed, the permit number, the total number of pieces in the mailing, the amount of postage chargeable on a single piece, and the total amount paid.

7. At the close of each quarter the postmaster shall send to the Auditor for the Post Office Department, together with the duplicate receipts of Form 3603, and the quarterly postal account, a certificate (Form 3604 for Presidential offices, or Form 3605 for fourth-class offices), showing the total amount of postage collected during the quarter on matter mailed under the provisions of this section, which amount must be charged in the quarterly postal account.

POLITICAL ACTIVITY OF FEDERAL EMPLOYEES.

Order No. 1756.

SEPTEMBER 24, 1908.

The attention of all officers and employees of the Post Office Department and the postal service is directed to the following circular issued by the Civil Service Commission, under date of September 1, 1908:

"The Commission desires to inform each of the Departments and Independent Executive offices of its attitude toward employees in the classified service who resign to become candidates for office or to engage in active political work, and who afterwards seek reinstatement. Inasmuch as the issuance of a certificate is discretionary with the Commission no certificate will be issued in any case where the party seeking reinstatement resigned with a view of running for office or indulging in a degree of political activity which would be prohibited if he had remained in the service and who afterwards, having failed in his candidacy, or having indulged in the contemplated political activity, seeks reinstatement."

This ruling of the Civil Service Commission was approved by the President, and the Postmaster General was so notified in a letter from the Secretary to the President, dated September 10, 1908, which reads as follows:

"I am directed by the President to inform you that he approves of the circular of the Civil Service Commission of September 1st in reference to employees of the classified service who resign to become candidates for office or to engage in active political work, and who afterwards seek reinstatement. His instructions and statements have been explicit, viz., that the people within the classified service stand on an entirely different footing from those without, and those within must not render political service of this kind. The President directs that the circular be complied with by each head of Department."

THE SPANISH SWINDLE.

The attention of postmasters is directed to the following scheme operated by swindlers from various towns and cities in Spain, who make a practice of writing to persons in the United States. It is desired that this information be communicated to the public through the medium of the press if possible without cost; or, if this cannot be done, that such other steps as may be practicable without cost be taken to disseminate the information.

The scheme consists in sending letters to certain persons, who have previously been selected by confederates. The foundation of the plot varies somewhat. In some instances the writer represents himself as a dying prisoner in a military fortress. He has a fortune on deposit in the United States, but the certificate of stock is concealed in a secret receptacle of his valise, which has been seized by the Court at Carthagena, and it will be held until the prisoner, or his representative has satisfied the cost of the trial. He claims distant relationship with the addressee. If the first letter bears fruit, it is quickly followed by others in which the prisoner's daughter plays a prominent part. She is in Spain without a protector. A proposal is made to send her, accompanied by

a priest, to the newly found relative for protection. If enough money is sent to release the valise containing the secret receptacle and the certificate of deposit. If the relative will accept the trust, he is to receive one-fourth of the prisoner's entire fortune of about 120,000 pounds. Of course, the "relative" never hears from the swindlers after he has sent the money requested.

Under the Spanish laws a felony must be consummated before the police may act, and a mere attempt to obtain money by false pretenses does not appear to warrant arrest. The money must be actually paid over, and the prosecuting witness must be present in person to testify; otherwise prosecution would be useless.

POSTMASTERS CONVENTIONS.

Order No. 1704.

SEPTEMBER 3, 1908.

Postmasters of the fourth class in the State of Texas are hereby granted leave of absence for as many days, not exceeding five, as may be necessary to enable them to attend the annual convention of the Texas League of Postmasters of Fourth Class Offices to be held at Dallas, Texas, October 21 and 22, 1908.

Order No. 1707.

SEPTEMBER 3, 1908.

Postmasters of all classes in the State of South Carolina are hereby granted leave of absence for as many days, not exceeding five, as may be necessary to enable them to attend the fifth annual convention of the South Carolina Association of Postmasters, to be held at Columbia, S. C., October 28 and 29, 1908.

Order No. 1725.

SEPTEMBER 12, 1908.

Postmasters in the Territory of Arizona are hereby granted leave of absence for as many days, not exceeding seven, as may be necessary to enable them to attend the meeting of the Postmasters' Association of Arizona, to be held at Phoenix, Ariz., November 11, 1908.

SALARIES OF REGULAR CLERKS AND CITY CARRIERS.

Paragraph 17 on page 49 of the Postal Guide for July, 1908, should be corrected to read:

"All payments to regular clerks and city carriers and all deductions for absence without pay should be computed by the salary tables of 1904."

POSTMARKS MUST BE DISTINCT.

The attention of postmasters is called to paragraph 1, of section 566, and paragraphs 3 and 4, of section 567, Postal Laws and Regulations. Postmasters will be careful to place a clear and legible impression of their postmarks on every piece of first, third, or fourth class mail dispatched.

The following instructions were issued from the bureau of the Second Assistant Postmaster General — Joseph Stewart, Second Assistant.

SEPARATION OF POSTAL AND POST CARDS.

SEPTEMBER 24, 1908.

In view of the modification of paragraph 1, section 611, Postal Laws and Regulations, by Postmaster General's Order No. 1237, April 1, 1908, discontinuing the backstamping of postal cards and private mailing cards, it will be necessary for postmasters and railway postal clerks, when making up direct packages for other post offices, to keep such cards, as far as practicable, separate from matter which requires backstamping. Where there is a sufficient quantity, they should be tied up separately.

ORNAMENTED POST CARDS.

SEPTEMBER 5, 1908.

The large number of post cards ornamented with tinsel, etc., improperly admitted to the mails indicates that sufficient care is not being given such matters.

Special attention of postmasters is called to paragraph 5, section 418, Postal Laws and Regulations, as amended April 26, 1907.

MISSENT MAIL.

SEPTEMBER 5, 1908.

Much difficulty in locating the responsibility for the missending of mail matter has been caused by the failure of some postmasters to mark missent mail as directed in section 610, Postal Laws and Regulations.

It is expected that the requirements of that section will be strictly complied with hereafter.

CANAL ZONE, PANAMA, VIA NEW ORLEANS, LA.

SEPTEMBER 23, 1908.

Attention is invited to the Foreign Mail Steamship Schedule published by the Department describing the sailing of steamers of the United Fruit Company from New Orleans every Saturday with mails for Panama and the Canal Zone, Panama. The sailing of steamers referred to should be taken advantage of in the dispatch of mails described whenever earlier delivery at destination will thereby be secured as compared with the sailings from New York of steamers of the Panama R. R. S. S. Line.

GALVESTON, TEX., AND FRONTERA, TABASCO, MEXICO.

SEPTEMBER 23, 1908.

Orders have been issued providing for an exchange of sealed mails between Galveston, Tex., and Frontera, Mexico, by means of steamers plying between the ports named. For the present it is understood the sailings from Galveston for Frontera will occur on the 1st and 15th of each month; and that the mails from Galveston for Frontera should comprise only articles addressed for delivery at that place, which will be expedited by dispatch by the steamers referred to.

GERMAN CLOSED MAILS FOR CIUDAD JUAREZ, MEXICO.

SEPTEMBER 10, 1908.

Information has been received from the German Office stating that, beginning September 1, 1908, the post offices of Bremen 1 and Hamburg 1, and the travelling post offices No. 10 Cologne-Veriers, and No. 15 Oberhausen-Boxtel each time when they make up dispatches of closed mails for Mexico, D. F., Nuevo Laredo and Progreso via New York, will also make up a dispatch of closed mail for Ciudad Juarez, Chihuahua, Mexico. In connection with the foregoing it is directed that special care shall be observed by clerks of this service to insure the prompt transmission of the new dispatches from New York to destination.

PARCEL POST.

PACKAGES FOR FRANCE.

SEPTEMBER 8, 1908.

Referring to Order No. 1575 of the 14th of July, 1908, printed on page 11 of the Postal Guide for August, notice is hereby given that a special form of customs declaration (Form 4402½) is required to be used in connection with parcel-post packages for France. Form 4402 is for use on parcel-post packages for all countries other than France.

Two copies of said Form 4402½ must be affixed to each parcel-post package addressed to France. Requisitions for said Forms should be addressed to the Division of Supplies.

PACKAGES FOR MEXICO.

SEPTEMBER 8, 1908.

Referring to the circular dated December 29, 1898, on page 1107 of the United States Official Postal Guide for January, 1899, relative to parcel-post packages for Mexico: United States postal officials are informed that the Postal Administration of Mexico has advised this Department that parcels weighing up to eleven (11) pounds (5 kilograms) may be sent to the following Mexican post offices, viz.:

JAPANESE POST OFFICES IN CHINA AND MANCHURIA.

AUGUST 29, 1908.

The International Bureau of the Universal Postal Union at Berne, Switzerland, has announced under date of the 13th instant, and at the instance of the Postal Administration of Japan, that the Japanese post offices in China and Manchuria named below, participate in the exchange of letters, parcel-post packages, articles of declared value, money orders, and articles marked with trade charges:

In China.—Amoy, Canton, Changsha, Chefoo, Chinkiang, Foochow, Hangchow, Hankow, Kiukiang, Nanking, Newchwang, Peking, Shanghai, Shaubakwan, Shasi, Soochow, Swatow, Tientsin, Tongku, Wuhu.

In Manchuria.—Antoken (Antung), Choshun (Changchun), Darlen (Talien), Dalsekkio (Tashichiao), Daitoko (Tatungkou), Furanten (Fulantien), Gaihei (Kaiping), Ginkaton (Newchatun), Gwaboten (Wafangtien), Hishika (Pitzuwo), Honkelko (Penhsihu), Hoten (Mukden), Howojo (Fenghuangcheng), Kaigen (Kalyuan), Kaljo (Halcheng), Kinshu (Chinchow), Koshurei (Kungchuling), Riojun (Port Arthur), Rloyo (Liaoyang), Riujuton (Liushutun), Senkinsai (Chienchinsai), Shibeigal (Supingehleh), Shinminfu (Singmingfu), Shoto (Changtu), Sokako (Tsaohokow), Sokaton (Suchiatun), Taikozan (Takushan), Tetsurei (Tiehling), Yendai (Yental), Yugakujo (Hsiungyocheng).

The list of Japanese post offices named in section 97 on page 135 of the Postal Guide for July, 1908, is hereby modified accordingly.

The following instructions were issued from the bureau of the Third Assistant Postmaster General — A. L. Lawabe, Third Assistant:

QUANTITIES OF POSTAGE STAMPS SUPPLIED.

SEPTEMBER 22, 1908.

The attention of postmasters is especially directed to section 33, page 27 of the July, 1908, Postal Guide, reading as follows:

"Requisition should be made for 10,000, 50,000 or 200,000 stamps of each denomination, or multiples of these quantities, provided it can be done within the amount of the postmaster's bond and the stamps will be needed within a reasonable time; that is, 10,000 2-cent rather than 7,000, 50,000 rather than 30,000, 200,000 rather than 170,000."

For convenience in handling, postage stamps are put up in sealed packages of 10,000 with the margin of the sheets stitched together. The issuing of stamps in this form is of advantage to postmasters as well as to the Department. Postmasters whose sales amount within nine months to 10,000 or more stamps of any denomination should make requisition for lots of 10,000 or multiples of 10,000.

STAMP BOOKS.

These are put up in packages containing 10, 50, 100, 300, or 500 books of 24 1c stamps; 10, 30, 50, 100, 200, 500, or 1,000 books of 12 2c stamps; 10, 50, 100, or 500 books of 24 or 48 2c stamps.

INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS.

PAYABLE IN HUNGARY.

SEPTEMBER 23, 1908.

In addition to the international money order applications with interlinear translation in foreign languages, listed on page 202 of the January, 1908, Postal Guide, Form 6701-m, with Hungarian translation has been prepared by the Department. These forms are designed to assist Hungarian remitters in filling applications for international money orders payable in Hungary, and postmasters at money order offices at which Hungarian money orders are issued in any considerable number during the year, should make requisition for a supply of Form 6701-m, addressing such requisition to the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Supplies.

CARE IN FILLING ADVICES.

SEPTEMBER 23, 1908.

The attention of postmasters at international money order offices is again directed to the necessity for greater care in filling international money order advices. Models of international money order forms with instructions as to the proper method of drawing such orders will be found on pages 11 to 15 of the "International List," a copy of which has been furnished to every international money order office.

The transposition of advices is a frequent cause of complaint, the particulars of address of the payee of Order No. 1, being entered in Advice No. 2, and vice versa.

Instructions on this head appear on page 20, paragraphs 21 and 22, of the Annual Postal Guide, July, 1908, and page 6, paragraph 3, of the International List.

Errors of this character will be avoided if:

- (a) The application is numbered before the order is issued.
- (b) The advice is completed at the moment the order is issued.

Drawing the order and advice, coupon and receipt should be one operation; if, however, this is impracticable on account of pressure of business, the advice may be completed subsequently at leisure, by entering in ink the name and address of the payee, and name of remitter. In such case the particulars in the advice should be carefully compared not only with the application but with the coupon bearing the same number.

LAREDO, TEXAS, (NOT EL PASO, TEXAS,) THE EXCHANGE OFFICE FOR MEXICO.

It has been brought to the attention of this Department by the postmaster at El Paso, Texas, that advices of international money orders intended for payment in Mexico, are frequently transmitted to his office for certification, instead of being sent to Laredo, Texas, many postmasters being under the impression that El Paso, Texas, is the exchange office for Mexico.

As this practice results in delaying payment of the amount to the payees of such orders, it is especially enjoined upon all postmasters at international money order offices to give the necessary instructions to the money order clerks under their supervision, so that such advices may invariably be dispatched to the correct exchange office, i. e., to Laredo.

CERTAIN REGISTERED MATTER FOR THE OFFICES IN ALASKA NAMED BELOW NOT TO BE ACCEPTED FOR REGISTRATION DURING THE WINTER MONTHS.

SEPTEMBER 24, 1908.

Postmasters are reminded that the season during which all classes of mail may be accepted for registration, addressed to post offices in Alaska, is now closed.

During the winter months, October 1st to May 1st, the articles permissible in mails for the post offices in Alaska mentioned below are restricted to:

Letters (in their usual and ordinary form); post-cards, singly-wrapped newspapers and periodicals from office of publication, addressed to public libraries, to newspaper publishers and to individual subscribers; transient newspapers and third-class matter of all kinds, except books, trade catalogues, circulars, and patterns and samples of merchandise.

The articles excluded are newspapers and periodicals sent to dealers for purposes of trade (in bulk or otherwise); sample copies of newspapers and periodicals; books; trade catalogues; circulars, and patterns and samples of merchandise, and fourth-class matter (merchandise).

The following notices were issued from the bureau of the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General — P. V. De Graw, Fourth Assistant:

COUNT OF MAIL ON RURAL ROUTES TO BE DISCONTINUED WHERE REPORTS SHOW 5,000 OR MORE PIECES PER MONTH TO HAVE BEEN DELIVERED AND COLLECTED.

SEPTEMBER 5, 1908.

Postmasters at rural delivery offices will discontinue the count of mail by rural carriers on those routes where reports show 5,000 or more pieces of mail delivered and collected per month during each of the three months included in the quarter ended June 30, 1908, unless any such routes have been ordered curtailed. Where count of mail is suspended, however, carriers will continue to render daily reports on Form 6 of the number of letters and parcels registered, the number of applications for money orders received, and the value of stamps, stamped papers, etc., sold by them.

On those routes showing less than 5,000 pieces of mail delivered and collected per month during the period indicated, count will be continued and daily reports rendered by carriers on Form 6.

The count of mail and report thereof on Form 6 will be resumed on routes on which the count of mail has been suspended by previous authority, where such routes have since been materially curtailed.

DESCRIPTIONS AND BLUE PRINTS OF RURAL ROUTES MUST BE CAREFULLY PRESERVED.

SEPTEMBER 5, 1908.

Complaints having been made by post office inspectors that they are at times unable to find official descriptions and blueprints of rural routes on file at post offices, postmasters at rural delivery offices are admonished to carefully preserve and keep readily accessible, descriptions and blueprints of rural routes, and all correspondence and instructions pertaining to rural delivery necessary to be preserved.

OLD FORM SUBSTITUTE RURAL CARRIER VOUCHER MUST NOT BE USED.

SEPTEMBER 21, 1908.

Postmasters at rural delivery offices will immediately discontinue the use of the old Form R. D. 4, substitute rural letter carrier voucher, on which in the lower left-hand corner appears the words "annual salary \$600," and will, if they have not been supplied, make requisition on the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Supplies, for the new Form R. D. 4, substitute rural letter carrier voucher.

In using the new Form postmasters will be governed by the instructions contained in paragraphs 1 to 25, pages 53, 54 and 55, of the July, 1908, Postal Guide, and where service is performed by substitutes in different months, the number of days on which service was actually performed in each month will be separately indicated in the blank spaces appearing in the lower left-hand corner of the voucher.

SIGNS FOR POST OFFICES

The attention of the Department has been directed repeatedly to the fact that many advantages to the traveling public would be secured by the erection at each post office of a suitable exterior sign bearing, with the words "Post Office," the name of the town or village in which the office is located. It is the plan of the Department to insist hereafter on the display of signs of this character on all post office quarters for which lease contracts are made by the Government. It is considered, furthermore, that all postmasters should cooperate with the Department to put into effect, wherever practicable, this plan to indicate plainly to the traveling public the names of the towns in which post offices are situated. No appropriation is available from which the Department may make any allowance for the cost of signs at third and fourth class offices, but it is deemed that the matter is of sufficient importance to justify the recommendation that each postmaster shall provide for the convenience of the public a suitable sign on which shall appear the name of the post office. **WHERE THE NAME OF THE OFFICE AND THE NAME OF THE TOWN DIFFER THE SIGN SHOULD INDICATE THAT FACT ALSO.**

Instruction of School Children

ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE POSTAL SERVICE

WASHINGTON, D. C., Sept. 18, 1908

ORDER No. 1742

Postmasters are hereby directed to confer with their local school authorities with the view of adopting the most effective method of instructing school children as to the organization and operations of the postal service. These instructions should cover such features of the service as the delivery of the mails, the classification of mail matter, the registry and money order systems, and particularly the proper addressing of letters and the importance of placing return cards on envelopes. Postmasters should arrange, if possible, to deliver personal talks to the pupils on these subjects and should give teachers access to the Postal Guide and the Postal Laws and Regulations and render them every assistance in securing necessary information.
