AMENDMENT TO THE POSTAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

DISPOSITION OF DEFECTIVE MAIL POUCHES AT OFFICES IN CERTAIN STATES.

Order No. 2485.

JULY 20, 1909.

Section 1351, paragraph 1, of the Postal Laws and Regulations of 1902, is hereby modified so as to read as follows:

On and after August 1, 1909, defective mail pouches of all sizes and styles from post offices and railway post office lines in the States of Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Illinois, Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Utah, Montana, Idaho, Nevada, Washington, Oregon, and California, should be promptly sent to the submall bag repair shop, Chicago, Ill. All other defective and serviceable equipment from these and other States to be forwarded as heretofore.

THE PARCEL POST.

INFORMATION POSTED IN POST OFFICES.

JULY 10, 1909.

A placard, 11 x 14 inches in size, calling the attention of the public to the parcel-post service to foreign countries, has been prepared for posting conspicuously in every United States post office, branch post office, station and substation.

Postmasters should make requisition on this office for the number of such placards necessary to fully equip their offices with the same.

Full information with regard to the foreign countries concerned, the limits of size, weight, and value, and the general conditions of the parcel-post, which will enable postmasters to answer all inquiries at their offices, will be found on pages 171 to 178 of the United States Official Postal Guide for July, 1909.

PACKAGES FOR MEXICO.

JULY 27, 1909.

Referring to the circular dated December 29, 1898, on page 1107 of the United States Official Postal Guide for January, 1899, relative to parcel-post packages for Mexico, United States postal officials are informed that the Postal Administration of Mexico has advised this Department that parcels weighing up to eleven (11) pounds (5 kilograms) may be sent to the following Mexican post offices, viz:

and that such parcels may *not* hereafter be sent to the following Mexican post offices, viz:

Consequently, parcel-post packages weighing not more than eleven pounds may be accepted for mailing to the Mexican post offices above named as well as to the Mexican post offices named on pages 175-178 of the United States Official Postal Guide for July, 1909, with the exceptions above referred to.

AUGUST 21, 1909.

Referring to the circular dated December 29, 1898, on page 1107 of the United States Official Postal Guide for January, 1899, relative to parcel-post packages for Mexico, United States postal officials are informed that the Postal Administration of Mexico has advised this Department that parcels weighing up to eleven (11) pounds (5 kilograms) may be sent to the Mexican post office of Asarco.....State of Durango

Consequently, parcel-post packages weighing not more than eleven pounds may be accepted for mailing to the Mexican post office above named as well as to the Mexican post offices named on pages 175-178 of the United States Official Postal Guide for July, 1909.

ADVERTISING MATTER DUTIABLE IN AUSTRALIA.

AUGUST 7, 1909.

In the first line of paragraph "(b)" of Section 85 on page 161 of the Postal Guide for July, 1909, strike out "25 per cent." and in lieu thereof insert "6 pence per pound or 35 per cent. ad valorem whichever returns the higher duty."

DIPLOMATIC POUCHES BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE AND THE UNITED STATES LEGATION AT LIMA, PERU.

JULY 29, 1909.

Arrangements have been made for an exchange of sealed diplomatic dispatch pouches between the Department of State in this city and the United States Legation at Lima, Peru. It is ordered that clerks in the Railway Mail Service shall promptly forward intact any such pouches which may be received by them.

DIPLOMATIC DISPATCH POUCHES TO AND FROM SANTIAGO, CHILE.

AUGUST 24, 1909.

The Department having arranged for the exchange of sealed diplomatic dispatch pouches between the Department of State in this city and the United States Legation at Santiago, Chile, and for the exchange of similar pouches between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at Santiago and the Chilean Legation in this city, it is ordered that clerks in the Railway Mail Service shall promptly forward intact to destination any such pouches received by them.

The following orders and instructions were issued from the bureau of the Third Assistant Postmaster General — A. L. Lawshe, Third Assistant:

SPECIAL ISSUE OF POSTAGE STAMPS, HUDSON-FULTON CELEBRATION.

AUGUST 19, 1909.

1. Postmasters are notified that the Department is now preparing a new postage stamp of special design, which will be ready for issue to postmasters about September 20, to commemorate the discovery of the Hudson River by Henry Hudson in 1609, and of the introduction of steam navigation on its waters by Robert Fulton in 1807.

DESCRIPTION.

2. This stamp is oblong in shape, about $\frac{3}{8}$ by $1\frac{3}{8}$ inches in size, and comprises a border containing at the top the inscription "Hudson-Fulton Celebration," with the dates "1609" and "1909" immediately thereunder on either side, and below this inscription in a curved line are the words "U. S. Postage." At the bottom on each side is a prominent Arabic numeral "2," with the words "Two Cents" in a panel between the figures. In the center is engraved a picture showing the palisades of the Hudson River in the background, with the *Half Moon* sailing up the river and the *Clermont* steaming in the opposite direction. In the foreground is an Indian in a canoe, and in the distance, just discernable, is a canoe containing four other Indians, the canoes representing the first means of navigating the river. The stamp will be printed in the same color as the regular two-cent stamp.

3. The new stamp will not be issued in book form.

4. There will be no issue of stamped envelopes, newspaper wrappers or postal cards to commemorate these events.

5. The stamps of the Hudson-Fulton commemorative issue will be placed on sale September 25, 1909, but are not to be sold to the exclusion of stamps of the regular series. A supply of the latter must be carried in stock by all postmasters. Stamps of the commemorative or of the regular issue will be supplied, according to the preference of the purchaser.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING REQUISITIONS.

6. To secure the Hudson-Fulton commemorative stamps, postmasters must use the regular requisition Form 3201, and write a large, plain capital letter "H" (representing the word "Hudson") in the space below the word "County" at the top of the blank. If this letter "H" is placed elsewhere on the blank, it is likely to escape attention in the heavy work of filling

thousands of requisitions daily. Requisitions should be mailed in a penalty envelope, plainly addressed "Third Assistant Postmaster General, *Division of Stamps*, Washington, D. C."

IMPORTANT.—This special commemorative stamp will be issued in sheets of 60 stamps, instead of 100, and all requisitions should be made for 60 or a multiple of 60.

7. The Department will not expedite requisitions for the commemorative stamps; they will probably be shipped about three business days after the receipt of requisition, but it is possible the demand for the commemorative stamps may be so heavy that all requisitions cannot be filled so promptly.

8. If requisitions are reduced or delayed in filling, postmasters will understand that it is because the Department's supply of the Hudson-Fulton stamps is not equal to the demand. If the Department finds it necessary to reduce a requisition, the remaining stamps will be supplied only in response to a new requisition, which may be drawn in time to prevent the postmaster's stock from becoming exhausted.

9. To avoid frequent orders, postmasters should also include in the requisition a three to nine months' supply of any other variety of ordinary stamps, postal cards or stamped envelopes of which they have not a full stock. Such other varieties will be sent immediately if the Hudson-Fulton stamps cannot be furnished promptly, and the latter will be supplied as soon as they become available.

10. The value of commemorative stamps handled must be included by postmasters in Articles A, B, C, D and 1 of their quarterly reports to the Auditor.

11. Money received from the sale of the Hudson-Fulton commemorative stamps must not be kept separate, but must be placed with other postal receipts and accounted for in the usual manner.

CORRECTIONS IN SCHEMES FOR DISPATCH OF REGISTERED MAIL.

CUBA AND CANADA.

JULY 24, 1909.

Correct Article 13, page 86, of that portion of the Scheme for the Dispatch of Registered Mail to Canada printed on page 86 of the July, 1909, Postal Guide, by the addition of the following counties to the list of counties embodied in Article 13:

MEXICO.

AUGUST 9, 1909.

Correct the scheme for the dispatch of registered mail to Mexico, printed in the July, 1909, Postal Guide, as indicated below:

Eliminate foot-note (1), page 92, of the July, 1909, Official Postal Guide. This will change the scheme so as to require that registered matter for the States of Colima and Guerrero, and for the city of La Paz, in the State of Baja (Lower) California, Mexico, be dispatched to the United States exchange offices mentioned in the body of the scheme, printed on pages 89 and 90 of the July, 1909, Postal Guide, opposite the words "Baja (Lower) California," "Colima," and "Guerrero."

Eliminate the words "See foot-note (1)" below the names of each of the Mexican States mentioned in the body of the scheme and referred to above.

NAVY YARD, PUGET SOUND, WASHINGTON—CORRECT POST OFFICE ADDRESS OF.

AUGUST 21, 1909.

The postmaster at Puget, Wash., states that registered mail intended for the Navy Yard, Puget Sound, Wash., is frequently missent to his office instead of to Bremerton, Wash. Postmasters are therefore enjoined to require that mail accepted for registration and intended for the Navy Yard at Puget Sound, Wash., shall be addressed by the senders to Bremerton, Wash., the correct post office address for the Puget Sound Navy Yard. (See list of Navy Yards, page 729, of the July, 1909, Postal Guide.)

REGISTRY POSTMARKING STAMPS FOR BRANCHES AND STATIONS.

AUGUST 24, 1909.

Paragraphs 70 and 71 on page 76 of the July, 1909, Postal Guide are hereby amended by providing that postmasters shall wait a reasonable time for the receipt from the Department of registry postmarking stamps for new branches or stations, before making requisition therefor upon the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General (Division of Supplies).

INSTRUCTIONS TO POSTMASTERS RELATIVE TO TRANSACTION OF MONEY ORDER BUSINESS WITH MEXICO ON THE DOMESTIC BASIS IN EFFECT OCTOBER 1, 1909.

AUGUST 16, 1909.

Postmasters at money order offices are hereby notified that on and after October 1, 1909, money orders may be drawn at any money order office in the United States for payment in Mexico. Such orders will be drawn on the domestic form, and for orders issued in this country the domestic scale of fees will be charged.

The instructions contained in Circular No. 6377 relative to the transaction of money order business with Canada, Cuba, and certain other countries, will apply in general to the transaction of money order business with Mexico; special attention, however, is directed to the following features of the exchange about to be inaugurated with that country:

ISSUE.

1. Money orders issued in the United States will be drawn in dollars and cents, in the same manner as all other orders drawn on the domestic form; but will be payable in Mexico in Mexican currency at the rate of two pesos for every dollar, and two centavos for every cent. The currency of Mexico consists of pesos and centavos, each peso containing one hundred centavos, and the Mexican peso is valued at fifty cents United States currency. Money orders for payment in Mexico must be carefully drawn on a duly authorized money order office in that country. The name of the office must be very plainly written, and the name of the State in which it is situated given. This is very important, as there are numerous offices of similar names in different parts of Mexico. In writing the name of the State the official abbreviation thereof may be used.

2. The alphabetical list of offices in Mexico authorized to issue and pay money orders, with the States in which they are respectively situated, will be printed in the United States Official Postal Guide for the month of September, 1909. It is suggested that, for ready reference, such list be cut out of the Guide and pasted in the Register of Money Order Post Offices.

PAYMENT.

1. Money orders issued in Mexico will be drawn in Mexican currency (pesos and centavos) and will be payable in the United States at the rate of one dollar for every two pesos, one cent for every two centavos.

2. The amounts of such orders will be in even numbers in so far as centavos are concerned, but should a money order be drawn through error for an odd amount in centavos, the paying postmaster will disregard the odd centavo, and pay the equivalent of the even sum. For example, should a Mexican order be drawn for twenty-five centavos, it would be payable in the United States for twelve cents (equals twenty-four centavos) only.

3. The paying postmaster in the United States must note on the face of each Mexican order paid, in red ink, for the information of the Auditor, the sum paid in United States currency.

4. A list of the numerals in the Spanish language from one to one hundred is printed on pages 206 and 207 in the Register of Money Order Post Offices published by the Department.

CORRECTION OF "LIST OF THE MORE IMPORTANT CUSTOMS OFFICES IN THE UNITED STATES AT WHICH CUSTOMS OFFICERS ARE STATIONED."

SEPTEMBER 2, 1909.

Correct the "List of the More Important Customs Offices in the United States at which Customs Officers are Stationed" by eliminating Seward and Kodiak, Alaska, Leavenworth, Kans., and Shreveport, La., from the list.

The following instructions were issued from the bureau of the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General — P. V. DeGraw, Fourth Assistant:

RURAL DELIVERY LETTER CARRIERS' PAY AT END OF QUARTER.

AUGUST 16, 1909.

To reduce work in the Department and to economize filing space, it has become necessary to prepare a new form of Rural Carriers' Vouchers (R.D.-6) to be used for payment of salaries for the third month of each quarter and which shall also cover payments previously made during that quarter. This form is also to be used for final payments to regular or temporary carriers who, for any cause, are separated from the service during a quarter.

For example: If a carrier serves at \$900 per annum during the whole months of July, August and September, this voucher should be used for payment of the September salary (\$75) and should receipt in the aggregate for \$225 for the "period from July 1st to September 30th." If a carrier at the same salary serves during July and a portion of August and resigns on August 20th, the voucher should be for \$125 and the receipt should be for the "period from July 1st to August 20th." The successor to this latter carrier, if he serves during the remainder of the quarter, should receipt on form R.D.-1 for his salary during the remainder of August (\$25) and then receipt at end of September on form R.D.-6 in the aggregate for \$100, to cover the salary for September (\$75) and to include the amount received for August (\$25), and the receipt should read for the "period from August 21st to September 30th."

Final vouchers on form R.D.-1 for the current quarter now on file in the disbursing offices need not be replaced by the new form R.D.-6, but it is desired that final vouchers be hereafter filed on form R.D.-6.

Future requisitions on the Division of Supplies for Rural Delivery Letter Carriers' vouchers should be made for a sufficient number of form R.D.-1 for use during eight months of the year and enough of form R.D.-6 for four months.

ECONOMY IN USE OF TWINE.

The jute twine now being furnished for use in the Postal Service is of sufficient strength to hold a package of letters with one wrap and postal employees are therefore urged to remember this fact when preparing packages of letters for transmission through the mails.

SUPPLIES FOR FIRST AND SECOND CLASS OFFICES.

Since the distribution to offices of the first and second classes of the List of Postal Supplies, issued by the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, requisitions received for stock rubber stamps in many cases have been made to include practically the entire list. As their publication was intended to make it possible for these postmasters to obtain the additional equipment only for the purpose of assisting them to expedite work in their offices, it will be necessary that future requisitions for stock stamps be made in largely decreased quantities and must include only those stamps which are absolutely required. Form 1580 only should be employed in requesting stamps from stock.

Item 312, Marking Crayons, and 372, Finger and Thumb Stalls or Pads, Coin Wrappers, Gummed Letters and Numbers, are only supplied to those offices at which the gross receipts are \$450,000 and over, or where the postmaster's compensation is not less than \$4,000 per annum.

WINDOW REGISTRATION RECEIPT

(FORM 1549-A)

August 21, 1909.

To All Postmasters:

Numerous requests have been received from postmasters to be allowed to use the new form Window Registration Receipt (1549-A) at offices where the number of paid registrations does not appear to warrant the use of this form.

Postmasters are therefore advised that the use of the new form Window Registration Receipt is not ordinarily authorized at offices where the number of paid registrations is less than 15,000 per annum. Requests for the use of this new form should therefore not be made unless the number of paid registrations reaches 15,000 a year, or unless there are some exceptional conditions existing which would make the use of the receipt especially desirable, in which case the conditions should be set forth in the application for authority to use the form.

SPECIAL NOTICE.

Money Order Business with Mexico to be
Conducted on the Domestic Basis
Beginning October 1, 1909.

Postmasters at all money order offices will please bear in mind that beginning October 1, 1909, money orders for payment in Mexico must be drawn on the domestic form, and the advices forwarded directly to the office of payment and not through Laredo, Texas, as formerly.

In this connection, special attention is called to Circular No. 6283, dated August 16, 1909, which will be sent to postmasters at all money order offices, and also appears on page 9 of this Guide. Instructions contained in Circular No. 6377 relative to the transaction of money order business with Canada, Cuba and certain other countries will apply in general to business transacted with Mexico.

A list of the offices in Mexico on which money orders may be drawn is published in this Guide under the head of "Money Order Changes."
