The following notice and orders were issued from the office of the Postmaster General—
Albert S. Burleson, Postmaster General:

POSTAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS, EDITION OF 1913.

The new edition of the Postal Laws and Regulations will be ready for distribution to the postal service about September 20th. It will be unnecessary for postmasters to make requisition for copies, as they will be furnished to the entire postal service as rapidly as possible.

AMENDMENTS TO THE POSTAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS, EDITION OF 1902.

RETURNS TO DIVISION OF DEAD LETTERS.

ORDER NO. 7360.

July 29, 1913.

Section 684 of the Postal Laws and Regulations is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. In making up returns to be sent to the Division of Dead Letters, every piece of mail matter should be post-marked by stamp or hand with the name of the post office and the date of sending to that Division.

2. Matter bearing postage-due stamps which can not be delivered (see Sec. 622) will be tied in one package, with a written statement as to the amount of such postage-due stamps, and will be inclosed in a separate wrapper or envelope plainly marked on the outside "postage-due matter." At free-delivery offices each class of matter will be tied in separate bundles and a facing slip will be put on each one, stating the number of pieces therein and the amount claimed for postage. (See Sec. 397 as to claim for credit for the value of stamps and for value of stamps on postage-due bills not returned or returned without stamps, and on matter forwarded to foreign countries, and on foreign undelivered matter.)

3. A copy of the advertised list must be sent with every return. The advertised list should give the name of the post office, State, and date of advertising. (See Sec. 665.)

4. All matter delivered or otherwise disposed of since advertising should be indicated by a mark drawn through the name on the list.

5. A manuscript list of each piece of matter of the third class of obvious value, and of all matter of the fourth class, whether advertised or not, should be sent with such matter. This list may be made on blank (Form 1522 or 1522½) for unmailable matter by changing the word "unmailable" to "unclaimed."

6. The whole return should be wrapped and securely tied in one parcel and plainly addressed, "Division of Dead Letters, Washington, D. C." and indorsed "Return of unclaimed matter from." (Here add name of post office.) A penalty envelope may be used for the address label, but must be fastened securely to the parcel. Where the return is too bulky to be tied in one parcel, a pouch must be used, so that all the matter will be received together. Returns from free-delivery post offices will be registered only when a claim for credit for the value of due stamps is included therewith.

7. Hotel and fictitious matter must be entered on a list (Form 1522½) and sent separately from other unclaimed matter.

8. Postmasters at free-delivery offices will use dead-letter bills. Form 1561, printed on blue paper, and returns from all other offices will be sent without dead-letter bills, but accompanied with copies of their advertised lists.

MEDICINES IN THE MAILS.

July 29, 1913.

ORDER NO. 7361.

ORDERED. That paragraph 4 of Section 494, Postal Laws and Regulations, edition of 1902 as amended, be hereby further amended to read as follows:

4. Medicines and anesthetic agents, which are not outwardly or of their own force dangerous or injurious to life, health, or property, and not in themselves unmailable (See Sections 480 and 497), may be admitted to the mails for transmission in the domestic mails when inclosed in packages in conformity with the conditions prescribed in Section 496: *Provided*, That the terms "medicines" and "anesthetic agents" shall not be construed to mean poisons: *Provided further*, That the article mailed bears the label or superscription of the manufacturer thereof, or dealer therein, or of the licensed physician, surgeon, dentist or veterinarian preparing or prescribing the same.

INVENTORY OF MAIL EQUIPMENT.

August 15, 1913.

ORDER NO. 7418.

An inventory of the number and type of all mail equipment, including canvas mail bags leather pouches, and locks, in the hands of postmasters, depositories, railway postal clerks and other postal employees, and publishers, will be taken as of 12 o'clock noon, September 20, 1913.

Equipment in transit from railroad stations to post offices, or vice versa, or in use by rural carriers or star-route contractors, shall be reported by postmasters at the offices from which the routes start.

Reports of inventory thus secured shall be forwarded to the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Supplies, on or before September 25, 1913.

Information as to mail equipment in transit on steamships and other carriers, not accounted for as on hand or in use as of 12 o'clock noon, September 20, 1913, will be included in a supplemental report to be submitted by the postmasters receiving same to the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Supplies, upon the arrival of such steamship or other carrier, at any time up to October 1, 1913.

The Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Supplies, will arrange to secure inventory of equipment in use by the Congress, Departments, Public Printer, and elsewhere in Washington, except in the city post office.

SEND IN YOUR SURPLUS EQUIPMENT.

August 20, 1913.

Mail bags, pouches and locks must not be permitted to accumulate in post offices other than those making freight shipments, or at other places, unless duly authorized, but be forwarded promptly each day to the mail bag depository. See full instructions on page 16, July, 1913, Postal Guide.

Any failure on the part of postmasters or other employees of the postal service to observe this order strictly will be charged against their efficiency records, and all post office inspectors and supervisory officers of the service are hereby directed to report every failure of this character that comes to their attention to the Division Superintendent of Railway Mail Service in which the delinquent postmaster or other employee is located.

POSTMARKING OF MAIL RETURNED TO SENDERS.

Aug. 19, 1913.

The attention of all postmasters is directed to the necessity for postmarking mail to show the date of forwarding or of returning it to the senders. This is especially important, because of the discontinuance of back-stamping, which showed the time of the arrival of first-class mail. In determining the time for returning such matter in offices where dating stamps are not used, postmasters should take into account the date of the postmark of the office of mailing, making due allowance for time in transit, and should be guided by paragraphs 62 and 63 on page 56 of the Postal Guide of July, 1912.

LETTERS FROM THE BUREAU OF PENSIONS.

OFFICE OF FIRST ASST. P. M. GEN.,

WASHINGTON, Aug. 21, 1913.

The attention of postmasters is again called to the importance of carefully observing the instructions relative to the treatment of letters from the Bureau of Pensions that bear a printed indorsement referring to the Act of August 17, 1912. Such letters must not be forwarded to another post office under any circumstances, and they must not be delivered to any one in case the addressee has died, is under guardianship, has changed his post office either temporarily or permanently, or, if a widow, has remarried. A change of street address in the same city is not such removal as to prevent a proper delivery of such letters.

Before delivering such a letter to a person other than the addressee the clerk or carrier having it in charge should be satisfied, by inquiry or otherwise, that none of the prohibitive conditions exist, in which case delivery may be made to a member of the pensioner's family or household who has been specially authorized to receive pension mail. The special authorization should consist of a written order signed by the pensioner and designating by name the person to whom delivery of pension letters may be made. Such orders should be filed in the post office for the information of delivery clerks and carriers.

Letters that are undeliverable because of pensioner's death, removal to the delivery of another post office, or remarriage, should be indorsed to show the reason of nondelivery and the date of death, removal, or remarriage, if it is known, and returned immediately to the Bureau of Pensions. Those returned because the pensioner is under guardianship should be indorsed with the name of the guardian if it is known, and returned under the official envelope of the post office.

In case the pensioner is temporarily away from the delivery of the post office of address, such letter addressed to him should be held in the post office for the ten days specified in the return request.

The proper indorsement and prompt return of pension letters is very important, and postmasters are directed to issue the necessary instructions to all employees who handle such letters.

The following notices were issued from the bureau of the Second Assistant Postmaster General — Joseph Stewart, Second Assistant:

LIQUIDS IN PARCEL POST MAILS EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND GERMANY. July 29, 1913.

The postal administration of Germany and this Department having agreed thereto, liquids and oils, pastes, salves or other articles easily liquefiable are admissible on and after August 1, 1913, to the parcel post mails exchanged between the United States and Germany, provided they are packed in accordance with Section 22 of the Parcel Post Regulations as amended by the Postmaster General's order No. 6928, of the 17th of March, 1913.

Postmasters and other postal officials will please take due notice of the matter.

NASSAU, BAHAMAS — MAILS FOR.

Aug. 22, 1913.

The Department is advised that, commencing August 28, 1913, the *Francis E* of the Saunder's Line, carrying mails between Miami and the Bahamas, will sail from Miami on Thursdays instead of Tuesdays.

PARCEL POST PACKAGES FOR BRAZIL.

Aug. 4, 1913.

Referring to the notice relative to parcel post packages for Brazil, contained in Section 106, on page 132 of the Postal Guide for July, 1913, postmasters are directed to require the indorsement "Sender's Risk" or "Delivery Arranged" to be placed on the address side of all parcel post packages destined for places in Brazil other than the cities of Rio de Janeiro, Sao Paulo, Bello Horizonte, Bahia, Pernambuco (Recife) and Para.

The postmaster of New York has been instructed to return to the office of mailing for proper indorsement or for restoration to the senders all parcel post packages destined for places in Brazil other than the six offices indicated above which are received at his office on and after August 15, 1913, without the indorsement "Sender's Risk" or "Delivery Arranged."

PARCEL POST PACKAGES FOR GUADELOUPE AND MARTINIQUE NOT TO BE REGISTERED. Aug. 25, 1913.

An asterisk should have been printed against the names of Guadeloupe and Martinique in the table on pages 130 and 151 of the Postal Guide for July, 1913. Parcel post packages for the colonies named cannot be registered, as is indicated by Section 117 on page 133 of the Guide.

Postmasters will please cause due notice of the foregoing to be taken and the Guides in use at their offices modified accordingly.

CHANGES IN RATES AND WEIGHTS.

ORDER No. 7349.

July 25, 1913.

On and after August 15, 1913, the limit of weight of parcels of fourth class mail for delivery within the first and second zones shall be increased from 11 pounds to 20 pounds. The rate of postage on parcels exceeding four ounces in weight shall be five cents for the first pound and one cent for each additional two pounds or fraction thereof when intended for local delivery, and five cents for the first pound and one cent for each additional pound or fraction thereof when intended for delivery at other offices within the first and second zones.

Sections 1, 3, 7 and 15, Parcel Post Regulations, are amended accordingly.

The pound rates of postage in the first and second zones shall be as follows:

NOTE.—The rate for local delivery shall apply to all parcels mailed at a post office from which a rural route starts, for delivery on such route, or mailed at any point on such route for delivery at any other point thereon, or at the office from which the route starts, or on any rural route starting therefrom, and on all matter mailed at a city carrier office, or at any point within its delivery limits, for delivery by carriers from that office, or at any office for local delivery.

Fresh meats and other articles mentioned in paragraph 2, section 34, Parcel Post Regulations, when inclosed and wrapped in the manner prescribed by the last sentence of that paragraph, will be accepted for mailing to offices within the first and second zones.

PARCEL POST MAPS AND GUIDES.

For the purpose of determining rates of postage on fourth-class, or parcel post mail, a guide for 55 cents and a map for 20 cents may be purchased, together or separately (the two are used jointly in computing postage), by sending a money order for the proper amount payable to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Finance, Washington, D. C. Postage stamps are not accepted. The guide is applicable to all post offices, but a separate map is required for each one of the 3,500 squares or units of area into which the country is divided, and it is, therefore, necessary in ordering a map to state at what post office it is to be used.

The usefulness of the map and guide which have been furnished postmasters and the public is not affected by the new rates for fourth-class matter mailed for local delivery, and for delivery within the first and second zones, effective Aug. 15, 1913.

FILLING OF REQUISITIONS FOR STAMPED ENVELOPES.

Aug. 19, 1913.

The stamped envelope factory at Dayton, Ohio, on account of conditions caused by the recent disastrous flood, is now about ten days in arrears in filling requisitions for special-request stamped envelopes, and is gradually catching up with deliveries.

Postmasters will notify purchasers of special-request envelopes of this announcement, and suggest that orders be placed in ample time to allow for present conditions.

DEFACING UNUSED HALF OF UNDELIVERABLE DOUBLE POSTAL CARDS.

Aug. 19, 1913.

It has come to the attention of the Department that many postmasters, in returning to the senders undeliverable double postal cards, either cancel or otherwise deface the stamp on the reply half. Postmasters are, therefore, informed that great care must be taken in indorsing and returning undeliverable double postal cards not to deface or destroy the unused half.

SEMIANNUAL STATEMENTS OF OWNERSHIP, MANAGEMENT, CIRCULATION, ETC., OF PUBLICATIONS.

Sept. 2, 1913.

The attention of postmasters is invited to the provisions of the Act of August 24, 1912, on page 5 of the October, 1912, supplement to the Postal Guide, requiring the submission of semiannual statements of the ownership, management, circulation, etc., of publications entered as second-class matter, and they are instructed to furnish at once to the publishers of the publications entered as second-class matter at their respective post offices, except those which have been exempted under the provisions of the Act, copies of Form 3526 for their use in submitting, in duplicate, the semiannual statement required to be filed on October 1, 1913.

When such statements are filed, one copy should be promptly forwarded to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Classification, and the other retained in the files of the post office.

Postmasters will report to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Classification, not later than October 5, the name of any publication which has not filed the required statement.

Requisitions for copies of Form 3526 are to be made on the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Supplies.

REGISTRY SYSTEM.

MAIL INTENDED FOR REGISTRATION TO BE SO WRAPPED OR ENVELOPED THAT IT WILL CARRY SAFELY IN THE MAILS.

Aug. 22, 1913.

Reports are frequently received that registered articles, especially those containing coin or paper currency, are received at the post office of address or in transit in a damaged condition. Investigation of these cases generally indicates that the damage was due to the improper wrapping or enveloping of the registered matter rather than to rough handling while in the custody of the Postal Service.

Postmasters accepting mail for registration are therefore enjoined to see that it is so wrapped or enveloped that it will safely carry in the mails with ordinary handling. It should be suggested to the senders of letters or parcels containing coin or bulky currency that it would be advisable to inclose the matter in cloth lined paper or canvas sacks under a paper wrapper strong enough to properly protect the inclosure, care being exercised not to inclose more matter under any one cover than will safely carry under the envelope or wrapper used.

CORRECTIONS IN THE SCHEME FOR DISPATCH OF REGISTERED MAIL TO CANADA.

August 21, 1913.

The following corrections should be made in the scheme for the dispatch of registered mail to Canada printed on pages 84 to 90, inclusive, of the July, 1913, Postal Guide:

Foot note 24, page 90, should be modified to read as follows:

PRECANCELED POSTAGE STAMPS.

August 28, 1913.

ORDER No. 7448.

Effective September 16, 1913, precanceled stamps may be sold to the public and will be valid for postage on second, third and fourth class mail at the office at which they are precanceled, regardless of the number of pieces mailed or whether they are identical.

Instructions for placing this order into effect will be issued by the Third Assistant Postmaster General.

CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF PRECANCELED POSTAGE STAMPS.

September 2, 1913.

1. Postmasters obtaining authority therefor from the Third Assistant Postmaster General may sell precanceled postage stamps to the public for use in payment of postage on matter of the second, third, and fourth classes, regardless of the number of pieces mailed at one time or whether they are identical. In no case may such stamps be accepted in payment of postage on first-class matter.

2. The application for permission to sell precanceled stamps should be made to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Classification, and should show the average number of pieces of second-class, third-class or fourth-class matter the person or concern desiring to use such stamps mails daily, weekly, monthly, etc.

3. On receipt of authority to sell precanceled stamps postmasters shall furnish them and accept mailings bearing them under the following conditions:

(a) The name of the post office and State, and two parallel heavy black lines, one above and one below such name, shall be printed across the face of each stamp.

(b) Stamps may be precanceled only under the supervision of the postmaster or a sworn employee of the post office.

(c) Precanceled stamps are good for the payment of postage only on transient second-class, third-class, or fourth-class matter when presented at the post office where precanceled.

(d) Postmasters should require the mail on which precanceled stamps are used to be presented in such manner as to permit of easy examination. To facilitate the handling of such matter in the mails, it is expected that the mailer will comply with all reasonable requests of the postmaster for the separation thereof into states, counties, cities, etc.

4. Postmasters shall carefully observe the use of precanceled stamps and promptly report to the Third Assistant Postmaster General, Division of Classification, any case of the misuse of such stamps coming to their attention, whether occurring at their offices or elsewhere.

5. In so far as article 34, page 12, July, 1913, Postal Guide, is inconsistent with the foregoing, it is modified accordingly.

INDEPENDENT STATIONS.
